Agenda & Minutes

- 1) Call to Order & Roll Call - **Chris, Chad, Tony, Bethanne, Annie, Rob, Evan, Cassie, Kevin, Jeff (remotely). Quorum reached, official meeting established, Chad called the meeting to order.**
- 2) PSC Member Comment - **Members in attendance - Chad MacD, Laura - who has a U9B registered to play this Fall. There were no comments - from attending members or Board Members.**
- 3) Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes. [PSC Board Meeting Minutes](#) - **prior minutes have not been shared, therefore effort to approval prior minutes was paused until they can be shared in advance of the next meeting.**

- 7) Treasurer's Report (tax filing reminder for July 1 due Nov 1; at season end, be sure to collect payments): **Tony & Cassie As of May 31st PSC was still operating at a loss of approximately \$4800 with one more month until completion of the accounting year. Tony noted that the club has not operated a fundraiser in multiple years. Cassie noted that the 6-month CD the club put funds into matured after the first 6 months and automatically rolled into another 6-month cycle. The CD account contains the initial \$15K plus interest.**
- 8) Registrar's Report:
- 9) Committees -
 - a) Nominating - (Chris and Chad have worked on this) - **Chris updated the group on current status. Of the 6 Board Members whose term expires at the end of June 2025 (Chad, Cassie, Rebecca, Kevin, Evan, and Jeff) - all have indicated desire to remain in their position. Also, the six current officers have indicated interest in continuing in their current posts. As such, Chris indicated the nominating committee recommended the entire 6 person slate to continue board service 'as is' as well as the six officers 'as is'. Evan Second'd the recommendation. There was No discussion or comments. All Board Members in attendance gave their favor.**

- b) Travel Soccer (**Bethanne, Kevin, and Evan**) Discuss evals, registrations, and team formations **Chris updated all on the numbers. Starting with the Boys** - there are 12 registered for U9 (playing 7v7). There are 14 registered for U10 (playing 7v7). There are 13 (with one VERY likely addition expected E.K.) for U11 (playing 9v9). There are 15 registered for U12 (playing 9v9). There is only 1 registered for U13.....It therefore appears that all the boys' groups are capable of rostering a complete on-year team in each of the U9, U10, U11, and U12 levels without any need for internal borrowing or merging with other towns. Based on prior performance data, the recommendation would be for the U9 team to register at the lowest competition level; the U10 team to register at a low/medium competition level; the U11 team to register in the middle of the competition level; and the U12 team to register as a B or C (middle to upper middle competition level).....Anne made a motion for PSC to form four travel boys teams for Fall 2025 as outlined above at the U9-U12 divisions in the recommended competition levels. Tony Second'd the motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed with all attending members voting in favor with zero no's.....Of note: Chad will reach out to neighboring towns to see if the lone U13 Boy can possibly join a local team willing to accept him.....Regarding the Girls: the numbers are a challenge at three of the five divisions, with the numbers as follows: U9 has 9, U10 has 8, U11 has 5, U12 has 13, and U13 has 1. At this time there is no interest or need move the U9's up to bolster an older group of players. Therefore, the U9G is the ONLY group that merits formation at this time, and they would be best slotted in the lowest competition level. Anne motioned to form the U9G team with the 9 registered players. Kevin Second'd the motion. The only discussion was that with the format being 7v7, a roster of 9 would benefit from a late registration or two if the materialized. As such, it would make sense to remain open to the possibility of allowing a late-comer to be added to the roster - however, no additional recruiting is recommended. Voting was 100% in favor, with zero no's.....At the moment, the remaining team formations will be tabled with effort to be made as follows: Chad will consult with neighboring towns to see what their numbers are like in said groups and with that data, perhaps merging can solve some of the low-turnout issues in U10 and U11; additional recruiting can also be done within town, even though reports indicate that the well is dry in that regard.....The options were discussed. One would be to merge our 8 U10's and 5 U11's into a 13-player U11 team. Chad MacD. noted that doing so would not be the best outcome. The U10's were not overly strong competitively and asking them to play up against older teams would put the team and the players at significant disadvantage, especially at the 9v9 level. The fact that only 5 of the 13 would be

playing at their designated birth-year is a second notable 'con' to the blended-team idea. It was also noted that last year's U11 team learned that the overwhelming majority of its competition fielded teams in the Fall and Spring, meaning opponents were more seasoned and played at least twice as much soccer as PSC's team which fielded players who only play in the Fall. Asking U10's who only have an 8 week Fall season under their belt to play U11 opponents who will more than likely have 4 seasons of experience (Fall 2023, Spring 2024, Fall 2024, Spring 2025) will create a notable competitive imbalance. It was also noted that, despite these 'cons' to the idea, once Fall 2026 rolls around and the age bracketing changes away from birth-year teams - many of the players we are discussing will be blended in the new format.....The possibility exists that PSC could form a large U12 team consisting of the 13 U12s and the 5 U11s. Pods may help solve the fact that there will be an entire 9 player team on the bench at any given time during games, with the idea being to schedule a couple extra Friendly's to buffer lost time when pod'd players miss a game periodically.....Chad will also see if neighboring towns are willing/able to accommodate our lone U13 boy registrant.....Finally - coach appointments were proposed as follows: U9 boys has 3 volunteer Assistant Coaches - and all are worthy of recommendation with the plan being the three of them can discuss who can take on a Head Coach title; U10 boys has Osa D as a volunteer Head Coach and John Spear as an Assistant Coach - both are known to the club and merit approval as noted; U11B have Evan as Head Coach with Tony, Don, Mike as Assistant Coaches and Marie as Team Manager - all are known and, although it was noted that four coaches is a bit excessive even if some/all battle some attendance issues, the group was recommended 'as is' for the Fall season (with the caveat that no more than two coaches would be 'on the bench' for any given games); and the U12 boys have Ingrid as the Head Coach with Steve M. and Laura (doing double duty with U9B) registered as Assistant Coaches - all are known and merit recommendation for the Fall season. It should be noted that Laura spoke independently to all the attending Board Members during the coach appointment phase about her reasoning for volunteering and shared her background as appropriate, with affirmative acceptance by everyone. Kevin made a motion to appoint the coaching trees for the U9-U12 boys as noted above, and Anne Second'd the motion. There was no additional discussion, and the vote showed 100% in favor.....It was also noted that a recent volunteer registered on the girls' side of the equation and Bethanne and Anne agreed to make contact to discuss the request to volunteer.....At this time, no girls teams coaches were recommended or appointed.

Section 5.03 Numbers

The number of Directors shall not be less than three (3) or more than Twelve (12), this number to be fixed from time to time by the Board of Directors. - 14) Open Discussion **Kevin mentioned how, despite the fact the teams were not formed or coaches appointed, the South Windsor tournament offered an early, pre-registration option for teams who were NOT allowed to participate last year due to it filling up within minutes of opening. The U11 (now U12) girls were in that predicament - and the SW Tournament director accepted PSC U12G pre-registration, with funds to be paid later. The cost of the tournament is higher than what PSC has ear-marked for tournaments (\$625 vs. \$500). At some level, the team - whenever it is formed and by whom it will be coached - will need to come up with a way to cover the gap either through fund-raising, parent and/or coach contributions, etc.**
- 15) Adjournment Bethanne made motion to adjourn the meeting. Anne Second'd the motion. There were no issues of discussion and 100% of attendees voted in favor to adjourn, with zero objections.
