2. Grade 3/4 (U10) and above – License/Certification Required

To answer a few of the questions:

Grade 1/2 (u8) Junior Referees.

- Must be at least 12 and at least in 7th grade.
- We will go over everything they need to know the night of the meeting.
- This is a great way for them to get their feet wet and see if they would like to pursue refereeing down the road and become licensed.
- The games are only on Saturday's in the 9:00, 10:45, 12:30, or 2:15 time slot.
- As we get closer to the meeting and the first week, we will reach out and start assigning games.
- We will email you near the beginning/middle of the week and just need you to confirm that your child can or cannot do the game assigned to them that week.
- Priority will be given to those currently enrolled in our Fall Program.

Grade 3/4 (u10) and above

- Must be certified Grade 8 referee
- Must be 14+ years of age
