Coach Pitch Division**



I. When does the Coach Pitch season start/end?

Generally, our Coach Pitch season is scheduled from early April until the end of May, however weather plays a crucial role in our timing. Weather contingent, our goal is to have the season completed around Memorial Day weekend.

II. Do the teams practice?

Yes! The teams are assigned times to practice prior to the start of regular season games. Traditionally, once games have started, your team will likely have limited or no practice.

III. What nights of the week are Coach Pitch practices and games scheduled?

We schedule Coach Pitch games on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday nights throughout the season. Start times vary between 5:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. depending on field availability and the number of teams. Occasionally we are forced to schedule make-up games or practices on a Saturday.

IV. What should we expect as a parent and player?

Coach Pitch is all about the fundamentals of baseball and teamwork. For many children, Coach Pitch is their first organized sport with other teammates. Coach Pitch is geared towards teaching the players the fundamentals of baseball and working together on a team. Parents are encouraged to assist with both practices and games. Bring a glove; coaches will need your help.

V. What type of equipment do we need?

The Boulder Arrowhead Little League will provide bats, helmets and baseballs which will be given to each team manager. This equipment will be used by all members of the team during practices and games. Our sponsors provide the baseball hats and shirts. Players are encouraged to bring their own helmets.

Your child must be equipped with appropriate clothing and footwear. We recommend they wear athletic type pants and athletic shoes/cleats. Your child will also need to bring their own baseball glove to both practices and games.

VI. What's next?

On or around April 1st, you will be contacted by your team's selected Manager who will provide you with a practice and game schedule. The Manager will also hold a parent meeting at one of the first practices to outline the season and other expectations.
