

As the parent or guardian of a player registered with Kempsville Pony Baseball I agree to the following tenets and standards of conduct:

1. Kempsville PONY Baseball is a non-profit organization chartered to help young people develop into better adults through participation in organized, supervised, competitive athletics. The goals and mission of the league include sportsmanship, teamwork, self-reliance, and self-discipline, along with how to win and how to accept defeat graciously.
2. To achieve our goals, it is critical for league members to volunteer their time and services for volunteer activities. Those activities include coaching, field maintenance, fundraising, and concession stand assignments. **Parents are required to work in the Concession Stand when their team is assigned.**
3. The physical and moral welfare of the young people for whose benefit the League was organized shall remain paramount in all matters. Adult supervisors, coaches, parents, guardians, and supporters shall always bear in mind that the attainment of exceptional athletic skill or winning games is secondary, and that the molding of future citizens is of prime importance.
4. As a parent or guardian, I will conduct myself in a manner befitting a supportive member of the league and mentor to young athletes. Actions by any parent or guardian that do not adhere to these tenets and standards are subject to action by the team manager and/or Kempsville Pony Baseball.
