



2026 NWARLL ALL-STARS PARENT INFO

The commitment for All-Stars is **big**. Why? Because if you cannot make practices or games, you are taking a roster spot away from someone who wants to play and is able to make that commitment. You can expect to practice a minimum of 2 days per week prior to the tournament. We are guaranteed two games (double elimination). After that, it will depend on the number of games that are won. It's important for parents to be reminded that participating in tournament play is a choice, and that while it is a privilege to play, it is also a commitment with added practices and games. If you realize that your player has several conflicts, it may be a wise decision not to submit your player for tournament selection consideration and allow another Little Leaguer® to have the opportunity to share in the experience.

We ask that you postpone any summer vacations until after your All-Star tournaments are scheduled to be completed as much as possible.

REGISTRATION:

NWARLL All-Star Registration is open from April 20- May 10th. Please use sign up form here and be sure to include ever division your player plans to tryout for. You are allowed to play multiple divisions during All-Stars as long as your player meets the game and age requirements.

All registration forms must be submitted by May 10th. If your player makes an All-Stars team(s) **all** required paperwork must be submitted by June 1st—**NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE**. If a player does not fulfill all requirements to participate (including residency verification, submission of a birth certificate, medical release and payment), they will be ineligible to play, and an alternate player will take their place.

As part of the Sports Connect registration, you will be required to fill out the Little League Residency & School Attendance Eligibility. Most parents completed this at the beginning of our 2026 season. If you have not done so, we recommend to start now.

Every player will need to submit either their original birth certificate or a CERTIFIED copy of one. We cannot take photo copies of these per LL rules. The league's player agent presents these to District officials to confirm the player's age. Birth certificates will be collected at the first team meeting and are returned to parents once verification is complete at the tournament.

ELIGIBILITY:

Who is Eligible for Baseball All-Stars?

League players **LL age** 8-16 who currently play on a NWARLL team. Please ensure you are aware of your player(s)' league age as it may vary from their actual age. LL age chart can be found [here](#).

Senior division can be from outside the league and is the only exception.

A player must have participated in at least 8 of the regular season games (*except for Senior level*). We will be keeping track of this for each player.

A player may be selected to a second (different division) tournament team if they're eligible once their first tournament team has been eliminated. They can only practice with one team until their current team is eliminated from the tournament.

COST:

Registration fee: A fee of \$150 will be charged for each selected All-Star participant. An invoice will be issued for payment after the team selection. Payment plans are available. There will be a limited number of player scholarships available for this tournament. This fee will cover uniforms including jersey, pants, socks, belt, and hat, field rentals and tournament fees.

Travel expenses: any instate travel and lodging will be covered by the families. Players and coaches' airfare, lodging, and some foods are covered for Regional and World Series Travel.

FUNDRAISING:

Throughout June, we will offer multiple fundraising opportunities for players to contribute towards their registration fees. The registration fee is required to be paid in advance. Fundraising participants will be reimbursed from funds raised. However, if you prefer, you can choose not to participate in the fundraising.

PRACTICES:

Teams will be practicing a minimum 2 per week all of June through tournament time in July.

Practices start the week of June 1st.

Locations may rotate between The Dugout and Kinyon.

TOURNAMENT DATES:

District and State tournament dates TBD but tentatively:

- Coach Pitch- Either last weekend in June or first weekend in July (Little Rock area)
- Player Pitch- Either first or second weekend in July (Little Rock area)
- Majors- 2nd weekend in July (potentially hosting here)
- Intermediates- 2nd weekend in July (*will go straight to Waco if no other teams*) (LR area)
- Seniors- 2nd weekend in July (Junior Deputy- Little Rock)

TEAM SELECTION PROCESS

The coaches will select players from tryouts for their respective teams. A player may be selected for up to two teams (if they meet the requirements).

When will the teams be announced?

All teams will be announced on or after May 17th.

Announcements will be made via email to families and posted on our social media and website.

Calls and/or emails will not be made to those who do not make a team.

What if my player was made an alternate?

Each team will have up to 2 alternates.

These players are eligible to practice with the teams but are not guaranteed to play or receive a uniform.

Families will not be asked to pay for registration fees until the player is moved into an open spot.

Players are welcome to travel to tournaments but cannot play if their name is not listed on the roster.
