Allstar Selection Process

Little League All-stars (10/11/12)

Roster selection:

Team Selection for Majors will be primarily decided based on a voting process. The nine league age 10/11/12 players that receive the most votes will automatically be placed on the roster. The remaining 3 roster spots will be selected from a combination of the next 7 highest voted 10/11/12 year olds. The last remaining 3 roster spots will be discussed and decided by the Allstar Manager and approved by the Allstar Selection Committee.

Voting Process: A member of the Allstar Selection Committee will hold a group discussion via email, text, or meeting for all major's division managers to discuss and recommend any standout players that they feel should be considered prior to any voting.

Managers of the current season's Majors division will vote for what they feel are the top 18 players in that division for that age group. The coaches' number 1 voted player will receive 18 points, the second choice as 17, and so on until they reach their 18th choice which will be marked as 1 point.

All voting ballots will be collected by the Allstar Selection Committee in a locked google document. The top nine players who receive the most votes will automatically receive a roster spot on the Allstar team. The all-star team manager and Allstar Selection Committee will discuss and decide the final 3 roster spots. They may choose to fill those spots based on the next 7 highest voted 10/11/12 year olds players.

Considerations for these 3 spots will be based on player availability, positions needed (ie catchers/pitchers), and season performance. No player is guaranteed a roster spot based on being the child of an Allstar Manager or Board Member.

11u All-stars (9/10/11)

Roster selection:

Team Selection for 11u All-stars will be primarily decided based on a voting process. The nine league age 9/10/11 majors' players that receive the most votes (minus any players moved up to Majors 12u) will automatically be placed on the roster. The remaining 3 roster spots will be selected from a combination of the next 7 highest voted 9/10/11 year old major's players. The last remaining 3 roster spots will be discussed and decided by the Allstar Manager and Allstar Selection Committee.

Voting Process:

A member of the Allstar Selection Committee will hold a group discussion via email, text, or meeting for all major's division managers to discuss and recommend any standout players that they feel should be considered prior to any voting. They will also do the same with the minors' division managers regarding league age 11 year old.

Managers of the current season's Majors division will vote for what they feel are the top 18 players in that division and by age group. The coaches' number 1 voted player will receive 18 points, the second choice as 17, and so on until they reach their 18th choice which will be marked as 1 point. Managers of the current season's Majors/Minors division will vote for what they feel are the top 12 players in that division for that age group.

All voting ballots will be collected by the Allstar Selection Committee in a locked google document. The top nine players who receive the most votes will automatically receive a roster spot on the Allstar team. The all-star team manager and Allstar Selection Committee will discuss and decide the final 3 roster spots. They may choose to fill those spots based on the next 7 highest voted players from Majors.

Considerations for these 3 spots will be based on player availability, positions needed (ie catchers/pitchers), and season performance. No player is guaranteed a roster spot based on being the child of an Allstar Manager or Board Member.

10u All-stars (8/9/10)**Roster selection:**

Team Selection for 10u All-stars will be primarily decided based on a voting process. Any league age 10 player that played in the Majors division and was not selected for the 11u Allstar team will automatically be given one of the first nine roster spots on the 10u Allstars. The remaining top nine roster spots will be filled by the league age 8/9/10 players from the minors division that receive the most votes (i.e. If two league age 10yr olds played in Majors and did not get selected for 11u Allstars, they will take two of the top 9 roster spots on the 10u Allstars and the top 7 voted 8/9/10 year olds will fill the remaining 7 spots in the top nine.) The last remaining 3 roster spots will be discussed and decided by the Allstar Manager and the Allstar Selection Committee.

Voting Process:

A member of the Allstar Committee will hold a group discussion via email, text, or meeting for all minors division managers to discuss and recommend any standout players that they feel should be considered prior to any voting. This would be the best time to bring up any outstanding 9 year old players who should also be considered.

Managers of the current season's Minors division will vote for what they feel are the top 18 players in that division and by age group. The coaches' number 1 voted player will receive 18 points, the second choice as 17, and so on until they reach their 18th choice which will be marked as 1 point. Managers of the current

season's Minors division will also vote for what they feel are the top 18 players in that division for that age group.

All voting ballots will be collected by the Allstar Selection Committee in a locked google document. The top nine players who receive the most votes will automatically receive a roster spot on the Allstar team.

The top nine league age 10 players who receive the most votes (minus any 10 yr olds from majors) will automatically receive a roster spot on the Allstar team. The Allstar team manager and Allstar Selection Committee will discuss and decide the final 3 roster spots. They may choose to fill those spots based on the next 7 highest voted 8/9/10 year olds.

Considerations for these 3 spots will be based on player availability, positions needed (ie catchers/pitchers), and season performance. No player is guaranteed a roster spot based on being the child of an Allstar Manager or Board Member.

Juniors Baseball & Softball / 5070 All-stars

Roster selection:

Team Selection for Juniors will be primarily decided based on a voting process. The nine players that receive the most votes will automatically be placed on the roster. The last remaining 3-5 roster spots will be selected from the next 7 highest voted players by the Allstar Manager and Allstar Selection Committee.

Voting Process:

A member of the Allstar Committee will hold a group discussion via email, text, or meeting for all juniors division managers to discuss and recommend any stand out players that they feel should be considered prior to any voting.

All Juniors players that want to be considered for Allstars must have completed and turned in Allstar Commitment form. Eligible players will be placed onto a voting ballot. Managers of the current season's Juniors division will vote for what they feel are the top 18 players in that division for that age group. Their top choice will be marked at 18, second choice as 17, and so on until they reach their 18th choice which will be marked as 1.

All voting ballots will be collected by the Allstar Selection Committee in a locked google document. The top nine players who receive the most votes will automatically receive a roster spot on the Allstar team.

The top nine players who receive the most votes will automatically receive a roster spot on the Allstar team. The Allstar team manager and Allstar Selection Committee will discuss and decide the final 3-5 roster spots. They may choose to fill those spots based on the next 7 highest voted players.

Considerations for these 3 spots will be based on player availability, positions needed (ie catchers/pitchers), and season performance. No player is guaranteed a roster spot based on being the child of an Allstar Manager or Board Member.

***In the event that there is only one regular season team in any given division, any players in that division who fills out the commitment letter will be placed on the All-star team for that division, given there are enough eligible players to fill the roster.

Known Conflicts:

Known conflicts **MUST** be made aware to the Allstar Selection Committee and included in the required Commitment Letter.

Known conflicts include, but are not limited to vacations, school events, and other sporting events such as select tournaments/games. The Allstar committee may opt not to select a player in any division, who has multiple known conflicts during any Allstar Tournament Dates.

Any player that is eligible to play up but has 3 or more total known conflicts for the tournament dates on the upper level team and less than 3 for their own age group, will be required to play at their own age group.

Players that have multiple known conflicts, or that are not available for the Allstars team in their respective age group and only want to be considered the next age group up, must still follow the same voting guidelines. If a player does not receive enough votes in their age/division to be presented to the Allstar Selection Committee for consideration for the next age group up, then they will not be eligible for a roster spot on that Allstar team.

Allstar Selection Committee:

Allstar Selection Committee will be composed of the following:

- Player Agent or designated Board members that does not have a child who is eligible for that team.
or
- President or designated Board members that does not have a child who is eligible for that team.

Allstar Selection Committee may vary for each Allstar team depending on the Board member's child eligibility on that team. No board member may be part of an Allstar Committee where they have a child that is eligible for selection onto the team.

Ballots for Majors coaches to fill out:

1. Top 18 players in Majors
2. Top 18 players excluding 12 year olds, in Majors (ages 11,10)

Ballots for Minors coaches to fill out:

1. Top 18, 11 year olds in Minors
2. Top 18 players in Minors excluding, 11 year olds (Ages 8,9,10)

Announcement of All Star teams:

All teams will be announced during the time frame of May15th - May 22nd

Not all teams will be announced at the same time

Players/Families will be contacted individually prior to public announcement of teams

All-star Manager/Coaches Selection

Coaches will have until midnight of May 1st to submit the google interest form that will go to the Board.

Criteria:

- Has filled out the provided interest form
- How well a coach represents the League
- Little League Volunteer Pledge (below)
- Record during the regular season
- Prior experience as a coach on a Little League Tournament Team

Selection

Manager (head coach) and first assistant coach will be chosen by the board of directors based on criteria above.

Second assistant and alternate assistant coaches will be chosen by the team manager after rosters are finalized.

No Manager/Coach is guaranteed to have their child receive a roster spot. All rosters will be filled based on the voting criteria for each age group. All coaches must follow the voting guidelines.

LITTLE LEAGUE VOLUNTEER PLEDGE I will teach all children to play fair and do their best. I will positively support all managers, coaches, and players. I will respect the decision of the umpires. I will praise good effort despite the outcome of the game.
