COACHES, please check-in at the Columbia Junior High Auxiliary Gym prior to your first game to pick up your team packet!

TURKEY JAMBOREE INFORMATION

1. All fields are located at Dacca Park, Columbia Junior High School, and Fife High School in Fife.
2. Field numbers are posted at each field.
3. Games for all division will begin as follows :
 - a. Saturday at 8:30 a.m. with the last game starting at 6:30 p.m.
 - b. Sunday at 8:30 a.m. with the last game starting at 6:30 p.m.
4. The Head Field Marshals / Ref Assignors are located at the green tents in the center of Dacca Fields and Columbia Junior High School.
5. All games are expected to start on time, so as not to delay the next game.
A team more than 5 minutes late, will forfeit the game.
6. We value our referees and ask that they be treated with respect by ALL coaches, participants and spectators. If there is a problem with a referee, please contact your Field Marshall at your field or at the green tent.
7. Each team is to provide a game ball.
8. There is a good chance you might be playing against a team that wears the same colors as your team. Please be prepared to change into another color = a different team jersey, pennies or white t-shirts.
9. WHILE SUPPLIES LAST : Turkey Jamboree sweatshirts and apparel will be available for purchase.

TURKEY JAMBOREE RULES

1. No score is kept. This is meant to be a jamboree/friendly game.
2. The WSYS Rules of Competition for Small-Sided Games as outlined in the 2022 Washington State PDI document will be observed with the following exceptions :
 - a. NO slide tackling
 - b. NO heading the ball
 - c. NO punts or drop kicks
3. Game times : U7 – U10 teams = 2 x 20-minute halves, with a 5-minute half-time.
4. Game times : U11 – U12 teams = 2 x 25-minute halves, with a 5-minute half-time.
5. Dacca Park and Columbia Junior High : Spectators AND coaches are allowed no closer than the penalty box to the keeper.
Fife High School : Spectators are required to stay outside the fence line.
6. Unlimited substitutions can be made, at proper times and with referee approval only.

This is a great chance to play some new teams and have some fun! Enjoy the jamboree!

TURKEY JAMBOREE FAQ

Q : How many players can be on my roster?

A: We are using the WSYS guideless for roster sizes

U7 / 8 = MAX roster is 8

U9 / 10 = MAX roster is 12

U11 / 12 = MAX roster is 14

Q : What is the number of players on the field?

A : Due to modified field sizes, we have modified the number of players on the field

U7 / 8 = 4 v 4, NO Goalie

U9 / 10 = 7 v 7, includes Goalie

U11 / 12 = 9 v 9, includes Goalie

Q : Can I use Guest Players?

A : You may use guest players from YOUR club if they have been added to your roster as a guest player

by your club registrar.

The roster also needs to be signed by the club registrar.

You can cross off any players who will not be playing.

Q : Can I make a special request?

A : Yes, you may make a request about games in the box labeled :

“Request if needed for league games.”

This info will be used by the scheduler to accommodate as many requests for teams as possible.

We will do our best to honor these requests, but is is not guaranteed.

Q : What are the sizes of the fields and the goals?

A : Field and goals sizes are as follows :

U7 / 8 = 35 x 25 yard field, 4 x 6 goal (NO Goalie)

U9 / 10 = 65 x 40 yard field, 6.5 x 12 foot Goal

U11 / 12 = 80 x 55 yard field, 6.5 x 18.5 foot Goal

Q : What are the length of the games?

A : Game lengths are as follows :

U7 / 8 = 2 x 20-minute halves, 5-minute half-time

U9 / 10 = 2 x 20-minute halves, 5-minute half-time

U11 / 12 = 2 x 25-minute halves, 5-minute half-time

Q : What rules will the referees be following?

A : The 2022 WSYS Small Sided Rules will be followed with the following exceptions :

NO slide tackling

NO heading

NO punts or drop kicks
