The organizational members of North Kingstown Flag Football League have created a coach's code of conduct to ensure that our coaches understand the expectations of coaching a team in our program and representing the North Kingstown Flag Football community.

- Remember you are a youth flag football coach. The game is for and about the children, not the adults.
- Instruct your players in the rules, and coach the team in a way as to motivate each player to compete according to the rules at ALL TIMES.
- Recognize that the referee is the sole judge on the field, and his or her decision is final.
- Respect the coaches, players, and spectators of the opposing team before, during, and after the game, win or lose.
- Teach each player, especially through personal example, to be humble and generous in victory, and proud and courteous in defeat.
- Realize, accept and practice the principal that a team's reputation is built not only on its playing ability, but also on its sportsmanship, courtesy and manner.
- Be responsible in caring for equipment, for care of fields prior to games, and for cleaning up the fields after the game. All equipment furnished is property of the league.
- Make sure that all kids play an equal amount of playing time.
- Be patient with all of your players when mistakes happen and highlight the positive things the kids display.

We want to thank you for your commitment to be a volunteer coach. You are a role model and the kids will look up to you. Make it FUN. Don't take this too seriously, have a goal to make sure ALL of your kids come off the field with a smile on their faces. If you do this we all WIN.
