#### WSA TRAVEL SOCCER ORDER OF COMMUNICATION

**Note:** All calls that reach the coaching director level will be shared and documented with a WSA designated board liaison.

3. If the coaching director and parent are unable to come to a resolution, the coaching director will document the call and direct the caller to **Mickey Kydes**, the **MKS Program Director**.

**Note:** At this point, issues that cannot be resolved at the MKS Program Director level will be directed to a WSA designated board liaison for resolution.

All matters of concern received by board members, administrators and volunteers should immediately be directed in accordance to the above order of communication. It is imperative that comments, promises and decisions regarding MKS coaches and/or its programs not be made on behalf of MKS by non MKS members.

Please understand that it is our intention to streamline the communication process, remove the potential for minor issues to develop into major issues and better develop and support our coaching staff. In the end we will have better documentation and information regarding our coaching staff and overall program effectiveness.
