

GREEN HORNETS BOYS LACROSSE SPRING REC LEAGUE

Kindergarten - 8th Grade Recreational division referred to by Green Hornets as Boys Rec Lacrosse.

WHO: CLINIC (PRE K – 2nd Grade) is made of two divisions:

- **NUGGETS (PRE K - Kindergarten)**
- **SCOOPERS (1ST – 2nd grade)**

WHAT: Clinic (Nuggets and Scooper) is a no body checking intramural division for Pre – K through 2nd graders. 2nd graders have the option to play in this no body contact intramural Green Hornets League, or the Anne Arundel County Rec League below.

WHEN: Team Selection and Practices for rec players start early March, games start in April and the season ends the week before Memorial Day. Stingers practice and play once a week at Kinder on Sunday afternoons. There will be once a week, optional drop-in sessions available starting in April, see your coach for more information.

WHO: Grades 3rd - 8th grade

While Select Teams will play single grade, the Anne Arundel County Youth Lacrosse League operates within a two year date of birth format. All Anne Arundel County games will be played on NCAA governed full fields.

WHAT:

Will compete in AA County youth lacrosse league [AACYLL website](#) based on level of skill and experience.

WHEN:

Clinic will practice and play at Shipley's twice during the week, w/ games on either Saturday or Sunday. 2nd graders will generally play intramural small ball, a few 2nd graders may be selected to play in the AACO league, see your coach for more information.

Pee Wees will practice and play at Cypress or Kinder twice during the week with games on Saturday.

Middies will practice and play at Kinder twice during the week, with games on Saturday.

Juniors will practice and play at Kinder twice during the week, with games on Saturday.

Select Teams will play in the A division in AACO league, and/or the A or B division in HOCO league.

Cost: \$125 Clinic, \$175 all other club divisions (Pee Wees, Middies and Juniors)
