When:

Clinic will practice and play at Shipley's twice during the week, w/ games on either Saturday or Sunday. 2nd graders will generally play intramural small ball, a few 2nd graders may be selected to play in the AACO league, see your coach for more information. Please note there is no Select 2nd grade division in AACO or HOCO, and therefore no formal Select 2nd grade team.

Pee Wees will practice and play at Cypress or Kinder twice during the week with games on Saturday.

Middies will practice and play at Kinder twice during the week, with games on Saturday.

Juniors will practice and play at Kinder twice during the week, with games on Saturday.

Select Teams will play in the A division in AACO league, and/or the A or B division in HOCO league.
