	•The build out line promotes playing the ball out of the back in a less pressured setting •When the goalkeeper has the ball in his or her hands during play from the opponent, the opposing team must move behind the build out line until the ball is put into play •Once the opposing team is behind the build out line, the goalkeeper can pass, throw or roll the ball into play (punts and drop kicks are not allowed) •After the ball is put into play by the goalkeeper, the opposing team can cross the build out line and play resumes as normal •The opposing team must also move behind the build out line prior to a goal kick and may only cross the build out line once the ball has been put into play •If a goalkeeper punts or drop kicks the ball, an indirect free kick should be awarded to the opposing team from the spot of the offense •If the punt or drop kick occurs within the goal area, the indirect free kick should be taken on the goal area line parallel to the goal line at the nearest point to where the infringement occurred

U8 rules are unique to SWYSA, adding a 5th player to the field (goalkeeper)

NO EARRINGS ALLOWED. Refs are instructed to NOT allow any players on the field with earrings, they MUST be removed.

No jewelry allowed unless otherwise stated in the Rules and Regulations.

Field Sizes are recommended dimensions. Adjustments to fit physical constraints or permanent markings is acceptable.
