The Club Website and Social Media Policy applies to all Board Members, coaches, volunteers, parents, and any participant with the Woodstown Soccer Club. WSC views these tools as an important tool for communication in its successes and opportunities for athletic and individual development.

Woodstown Soccer Club aspires to engage members of the Woodstown community in a positive, honest, transparent, and knowledgeable dialogue about WSC through social media. WSC also views social media as a platform for receiving constructive feedback from the community and discussing WSC challenges and opportunities for improvement in a positive and constructive way.

ALL WSC members shall abide by the following guidelines when using social media:

1. Be positive and respectful.
2. Be aware that photos can create a privacy and safety risk for some individuals. If a photo includes children who are not yours, you **MUST** get consent from the parent/s of the child/children before submitting the photo.
3. Use good judgement when posting content and DO NOT post content that would harm anyone.
4. Encourage others to engage in positive interactions.
5. Personal information (name, address, date of birth, etc.) shall not be disclosed in any manner on the WSC social networking sites.

The Woodstown Soccer Club Board has the authority to monitor and enforce this Policy. The WSC Board has the right to remove any inappropriate or offensive comments from the sites and to block any individual or organization from posting on any platform if they determine the removal or block is in the best interest of WSC.
