Our Most Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When Does Registration Open:

A: Registration for the 2026 Season opens on May 1st.

Q: How Much is Registration:

A: Registration is \$160 for the first player, \$320 for two players, \$350 for three players. Family maximum payment is \$450. TOPSoccer registration is \$50 per player.

Q: Who Can Register:

A: Players range from PreK to 9th grade for our main program. All PreK players must turn 3 before September 1st 2026 to be eligible. Referees entering 7th grade for the 2026-2027 school year are eligible to register. TOPSoccer Players range from ages 3-18; and TOPS Buddies must turn 13 Prior to the start of the season

Q: Why is there a registration fee? Can I avoid it by writing a check or using PayPal / Venmo? A: A nominal fee is added to each family's registration. We cannot offset this fee by paying by check or e-payments. The fee is assessed directly by Sports Connect, our website hosting platform, and is their fee to use their player insurance site, conduct coaches training, and host our website. BITS cannot remove this fee from any registration, it does not go to the club – it goes directly to Sports Connect.

Q: When are the games?

A: All BITS Games are played at White Oak Park, on Saturdays. 9:00 am: Pre-K, 6th -9th Grade, TOPS.

10:45am: Kindergarten/1st Grade, 4th -6th Grade

12:30 pm: 2nd -3rd Grade.

Q: When are the practices?

A: For Players in Grades 2-6, there are five Monday Night Clinics that we hold during the season (schedule TBD), as well as a planned Goalie Clinic. Additionally, coaches for Grades K-9 may hold additional practices during the week at their discretion, for team development. These practices are NOT SET BY BITS, they are set by individual parent

coaches, and will be communicated to the team in September, once the season starts. Players in Pre-K do not have weekly practices or clinics, their only time slot is Saturday morning

Q: When does the Season start and end?

A: Our 10-week season starts Saturday, September 12th; and ends Saturday November 14th.

Q What about Uniforms?

A: BITS provides a reversible pinnie for Pre-K, K, and 1. 2nd -9th receive a blue shirt and a white shirt for home and away games. Players should wear black shorts or pants with their pinnie/shirts to complete their uniform. Socks, cleats and shin guards **MUST** be worn for all games.

Q: My child is getting their ears pierced over the summer. Can they wear earrings?

A: No Jewelry may be worn during BITS games, practices or clinics. Parents who are planning to have children's ears pierced over the summer, please keep this in mind that **ALL EARRINGS MUST BE REMOVED PRIOR TO EACH GAME**. No tape or Band-Aids may be worn over the earrings.
