

The Garrett Warhurst Memorial Scholarship

Information and Application

What is this award?

- The Garrett Warhurst Memorial Scholarship was established in 2011 as a memorial to Garrett Warhurst, a champion of baseball and participant in the Johnson County 3&2 baseball program. Its purpose is to offer a scholarship that provides financial assistance to qualified, graduating high school seniors. This scholarship exists as the result of the Warhurst's many family members, friends and acquaintances contributions.
- Garrett's exuberant personality, playful attitude and ability to not take life too seriously were qualities that were openly embraced by not only his teammates, but also all who he encountered. Scholarship will include a \$1,000 award, renewable for up to 4 years. The individual awarded must maintain a 2.6 GPA throughout his 4 years.

Who Is Eligible?

- For the Garrett Warhurst Memorial Scholarship, applicants must be a graduating high school senior, in need of financial aid and has played or worked in the 3&2 program for at least 2 years.

What is the Selection Criteria?

- For the Garrett Warhurst Memorial, applicants must demonstrate good moral standards, a positive attitude, a willingness to succeed and, above all, a desire to make a positive difference in their life and the lives of others. A large emphasis will be placed on applicant's financial need, as Garrett truly valued sharing and giving to those less fortunate.

Application

Please provide responses to the following demographic information and other questions with regard to your application in narrative form.

- Name of applicant and all contact information.
- High school from which you graduated.
- Cumulative grade point average.
- FAFSA EFC (Expected Family Contribution) number showing what your family's contribution should be to your college education.
- How you demonstrate good moral standards.
- How you have a positive attitude and a willingness to succeed.
- How you have made or are making a positive difference in the lives of others.
- Explain your years of experience at 3&2 as a player or employee, including years of participation.

In addition to the essay, a letter of recommendation from two individuals (non-family members) is required. These individuals may be teachers, coaches, community or business leaders, or church leaders.
