Requirements of Member to Run for Office. In order for a member to be entitled to run for the office of President, he/she must have served on the Board of Directors for the two-year period immediately preceding the election. In order for a member to run for any other Executive Officer position, he/she must be a member in good standing with the Club for the two-year period immediately preceding the election. In addition, he/she must have served as a commissioner or director of one of the Club's athletic or other activities for the two-year period immediately preceding the election. An individual's status as a member in good standing in the Club shall be determined by the Board of Directors in its sole and absolute discretion.

Requirements of Member to Run for Office.
