    - Might get some fields back
    - SB2 is closed maybe April date to use
    - New program manager coming aboard
  - Pitch In for Baseball/Softball
    - Grant we received
    - Received kits
    - Will put together an email for families
      - For need will need specific things from families to qualify
    - Kits for ages 7-9
    - 5 baseball and 5 softball
      - Softball had 12" balls instead of 11" balls so we swapped them out for the correct size.
  - Run Derby & Pitch, Hit, Run
    - o Pitch, Hit, Run MLB
      - Skills competition for kids
        - Measure pitch, note hits, and timed run
      - Winners go on to a regional competition
      - At some point winners get to go to Chase field

  - Discussion regarding approved bats for MP
  - Pursuant to Little League rules "Approved Tee Ball bats may also be used for Coach Pitch/Machine Pitch Minor divisions only with the use of approved Tee Balls." HDLL does not use tee balls in the MP division therefore bats stamped with language that indicates the bat is for use with teeballs may not be used in the MP division. teeballs

- G. Softball Director Eric Gallinger
  - Coach Pitch Status
    - o All needed managers have been found might still need more coaches
    - Need to get last set of equipment out
  - Coach Assist in Player Pitch
    - o Confirm that at the mid-point of the season, coach assist will no longer be utilized.
      - Need to confirm that this will be acceptable for interleague play
  - Clinics
    - Encountering some scheduling challenges for coaches
    - Will continue reaching out to others (other coaches who can run a clinic???)

- J. Scheduling Coordinator Adam Raley
  - Scheduling Updates
    - o 90% done
    - Few things to add
    - Already getting requests about conflicting schedules
    - Schedules should be posted this weekend
    - Maybe offer practice schedules for spring break based on coach desire
    - Anthem Days we cannot use fields (wed-sun)
  - Batting Cages in March
    - For those two weeks where we don't have games
      - Would like to offer time to teams
      - Anthony willing to work with us and give us a small discount (i.e. 10%)
    - Since Spring Registration and Sponsorships are a little more than budgeted, it would be good use to pay for one session for each kid pitch team – maybe machine pitch too if possible
      - Maybe put on the coaches to schedule the time?
    - Maybe if it is a rainout Anthony can invoice HDLL for 50% of the cost?
      - Minimize money transfers
      - Must have approval ahead of time
    - Explore options
- K. Umpire Coordinator Tyler Berns not present report by AR
  - Status of volunteer umpires
    - Unknown
    - Opening day in two weeks
      - No Umpires yet
        - Might have juniors but no adults
    - Not set-up and don't have a clear list of who umpires might be.
      - No background checks due to this

    - Unknown
  - Another clinic coming up hoping for better attendance
- L. Concessions Coordinator Suzi Sunders
  - Restocking both concessions this month
  - Sign Up Genius for volunteer workers as soon as game schedule is available. Will forward link to local honor societies at schools and post to website.
  - Possible training board on opening/closing procedures for help during season.
    - BOD members reach out for training
  - Team snack flyer for an email
    - Will work with Crystal

  - Uniforms All sponsors sent to Jessi 2/9 for printing (aligned with banners / Amity) will follow up next week to figure out return date and will email coaches accordingly.
  - Pictures Sent Tosh the list of teams and their corresponding rosters 2/10 with opening day schedule for planning out the day.
    - Sent preliminary schedule for review by President and Uniforms/Pictures
    - Not set out to families yet
  - Awards Sent Ruth final count for pin/trophy ordering working to confirm this by end of February for ordering.

    - o Amity/Tara did a great job getting teams sponsored.
  - Banner status
    - All info at PostNet now
    - Two Tball teams picked the same team name, hopefully we got that info in time for the banner so we don't have to replace.
  - Other grants
    - Floating around but need to be explored
- O. Events Coordinator Courtney Collins
  - Raffle ticket and flyers went out for Monday practices, Tuesday/Wednesday were cancelled, but Thursday nights were covered. Doing best for Saturday, enlisted Tara and Adam to help.
    - Will work on getting the missed teams next week.
  - Opening Day update
    - Bouncy house invoice came in maybe take one off due to space constraints.
      - Currently 6 bouncy houses (2 for young, 2 for middle aged, and 2 for older kids)
        - Unmanned so age groups is important.
      - Plus 2 inflatable activities single person at a time
      - Should we take some off don't need 8 inflatables, total quote is \$3096.79 for bounce houses and generators – remove bounce house and add chairs to still not go above the \$3090.79.
        - Remove the football one since we are baseball.
      - Vote to spend maximum and then figure out what to remove.
    - Paying for amphitheater \$150 per hour plus sound and deposit
    - o DJ Quote for the day and the announcing of the teams is \$425 includes all equipment.
      - Would start at amphitheater and then move to softball from 10-3 and willing to help with raffle.
    - o Raffle is mostly sponsored only about \$52 on us so far.
    - Maximum cost of \$4000 for opening day for bouncy house and chairs
      - Motion to Approve by Adam Raley. Seconded by Kristin Patrick. Motion Carries.
    - Professional photographer for opening day idea, \$250 cost. Can be used for marketing and for families to use.
    - Friday night March. 3<sup>rd</sup>
      - Received reports of significant number of Majors/AAA players whose games will conflict with Core5 football
        - Possible solution would be to flip flop AAA and Majors games to help accommodate player conflict with Core5 championship games
