3. New Business: Officer Reports

- A. President Alison Ryan

 - iii. District UIC said he would be finalizing the umpire training schedule this week. He would like to meet with each League Umpire Coordinator and President.
 - ACC Updates Field scheduling issues in the past week. Some teams locked out of field on Monday. Shipped teams over to Anthony (received a discount) and rescheduled to take care of teams. Working on scheduling any teams with low games.
 - Anyone who hasn't had a background check in the past year, needs to do so.
 - A long time coach passed away recently. Maybe do something for the family. Any suggestions.
 - i. Maybe offer his son a scholarship for the next season he registers for.
 - ii. Maybe a memorial on trailer/truck during Veteran's Day parade.
 - iii. Maybe initials on sleeves of jerseys for Spring season.
 - iv. Ensure family approves.

C. Treasurer – Ben Grindel

- Need to approve budget.
- Concerns over inflation fields and umpire cost.
 - i. Maybe an across the board 5-10% fee increase to help with field costs. Increases may not kick in until All Stars and the beginning of Fall 23'.

- ii. Uniform and equipment costs are showing increases in cost.
- iii. Umpires have not accounted for the two man crew cost. Adds up over the season of about \$40 per Majors player. Juniors need umpire too.
- iv. Maybe to set fees as T-ball \$150, Machine Pitch \$190, AA/AAA \$250, Majors \$285, Juniors \$295 is suggested. But wanting to keep families. Softball would be very similar in increases.
 - 1. Vote later, perhaps by email by email must be 100% unanimous and 100% voting. Otherwise, vote at next meeting.
 - 2. Still seems like a good deal when compared to other sports offerings.
