



The George “Bill” W. Tabor III Scholarship

The George “Bill” W. Tabor III Scholarship will be given out in memory of Bill Tabor (1942-2015) to a Northeast United (NEU) player that is in their senior year of high school and plan to attend college as a freshman in September of 2026. The college scholarship will be a one-time gift presented to the player at the end of the academic school year. Bill Tabor served as a Soccer Coach, District Vice President, Registrar and was instrumental in the creation and nurturing of NEU into one of the most prominent premier soccer programs in Connecticut.

Criteria for Consideration

1. Must be a Northeast United Soccer Club player.
2. Must have a C+ average or better and a 2026 high school graduate.
3. Must plan on attending a school of higher education as a freshman in September 2026.
4. Must submit a typed 250-word essay on “How Soccer Has Influenced My Life”.
5. Application and essay must be received no later than April 30, 2026. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
