- A. Emphasis of the youth organization

- B. Get to practice & games

- C. Constant communication

- E. Behavior and approach with coaches
 - 1. Quickly give a round of applause for the individuals that have volunteered to coach this season.
 - 2. 24 hour rule If an issue arises during a game, wait 24 hours before contacting the coach to discuss.
 - 3. Coaches coach the kid
 - 4. Support your child and coach
 - 5. Everyone will get a chance to play, but it will not always be equal.
