What exactly is All-Stars?

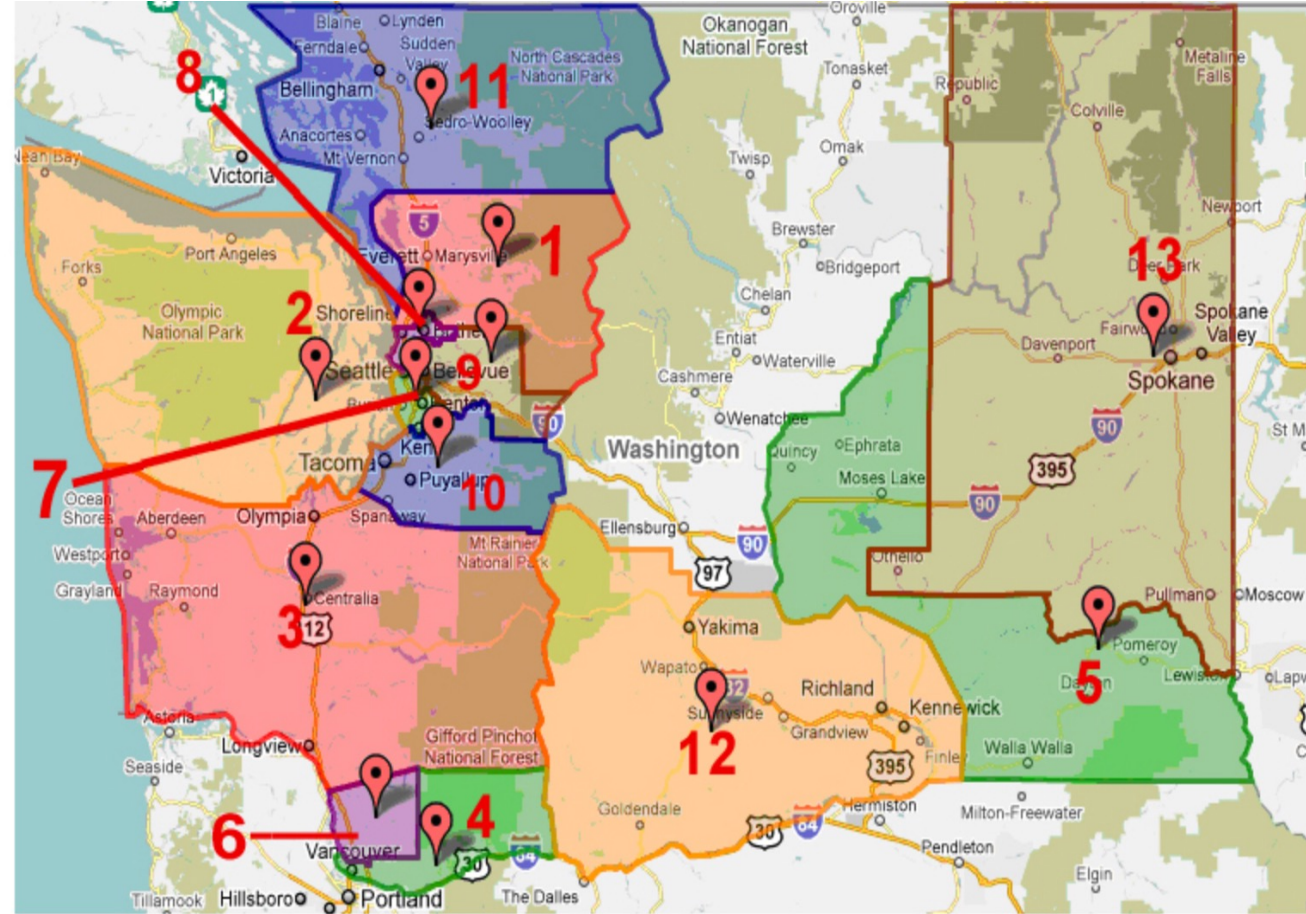
All-Stars are the summer tournament teams selected by local Little League organizations to participate in their respective District Tournaments.



Everett Little League is part of District One, which is one of 13 districts that make up Washington State Little League.

We can have Baseball and Softball All-Stars Teams in the following divisions:

- 10U (9 & 10 year olds)
- 11U (9, 10 & 11)
- 12U (10, 11 & 12)
- Intermediates (11, 12, 13)
- Juniors (12, 13 & 14)
- Seniors (13, 14, 15 & 16)



Picking All-Stars Teams



All-Stars players will be selected based on both their performance at the All-Stars showcase AND each player's regular season play. If you cannot attend the showcase you must notify the Player Agent.

- Those who have excelled and grown during their regular season games

The standard for our All-Stars teams is higher than the regular season, and we ask more of our softball and baseball players.





Rosters will be selected by...

1. The Manager of each specific team
2. The League President
3. The Vice Presidents of Baseball & Softball
4. The Player Agent

Final decisions on All Star rosters will be made within 48 hours of the All-Stars Showcases.

What is the commitment?



We request that your player is available for every game of their respective tournament. Managers must be notified of any absence immediately.



All Star teams will generally practice up to **five times per week**, immediately following the conclusion of their regular season.



There is no mandatory playing time in the field in All Stars, just Continuous Batting Order. Managers will put line ups forward that they believe will best help the team. **If you are not prepared for your player to not get playing time, we recommend not participating in All Stars.**



All teams will have a 24 hour rule – please do not reach out to the Manager about any concerns for 24 hours after games. This will allow cooler heads to prevail.



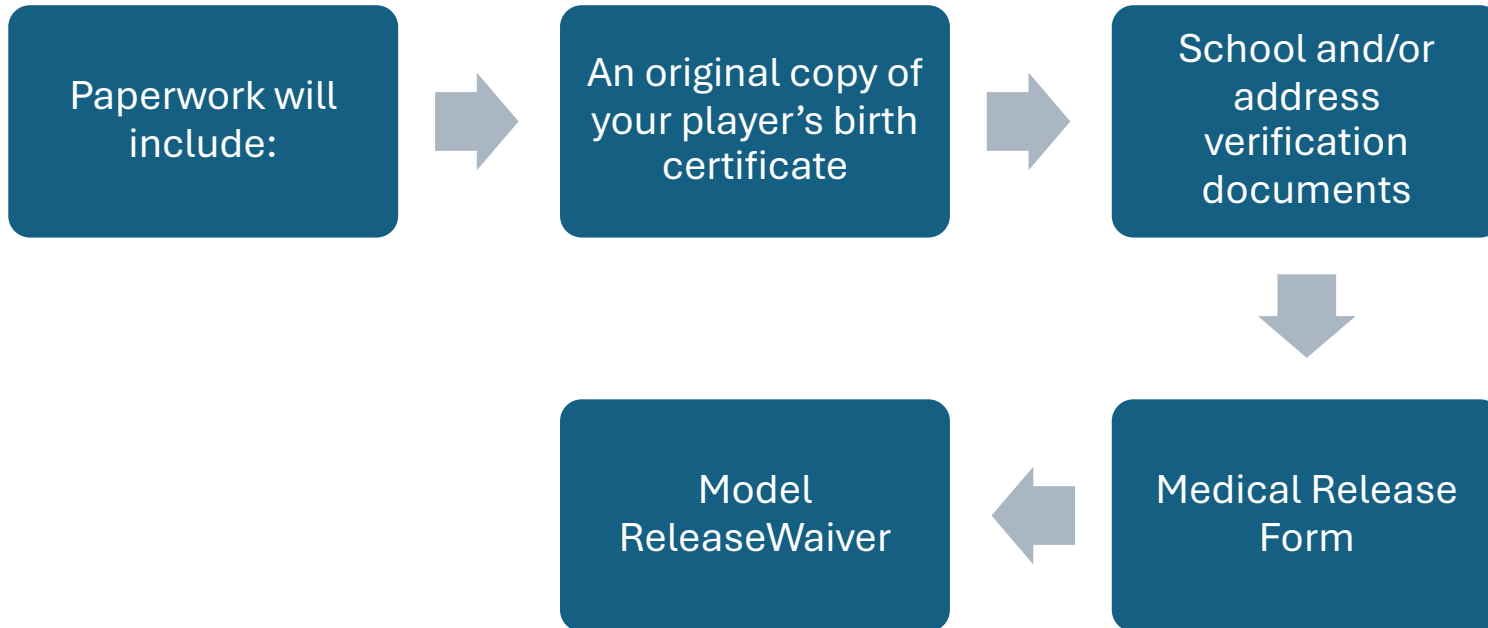
All Stars is more competitive than the regular season, and the expectation on your player will be higher. If you are selected, prepare them for this!



Necessary Documents



If your player is accepted on to an All-Stars roster, there will be paperwork that you are required to provide. This process will be guided by the League Player Agent.



ALL-STARS REGISTRATION FEE

The 2026 Fee to participate in All Stars is \$125 per player. This fee will cover the cost of uniforms and other expenses as they arise.



What happens after the district tournament?



- 10U and 11U teams that are victorious in the District One tournament would move on to play in the Washington State Tournament.
- 12U and Teen Ball Baseball and Softball teams who win their district tournament move on to their state tournament.
- 12U & Teen Ball State Tournament winners then move on to their respective Regional Tournaments.
- Regional Tournament winners complete in the Little League Baseball and Softball World Series.
