* League has batting helmets that players can sign out for the season

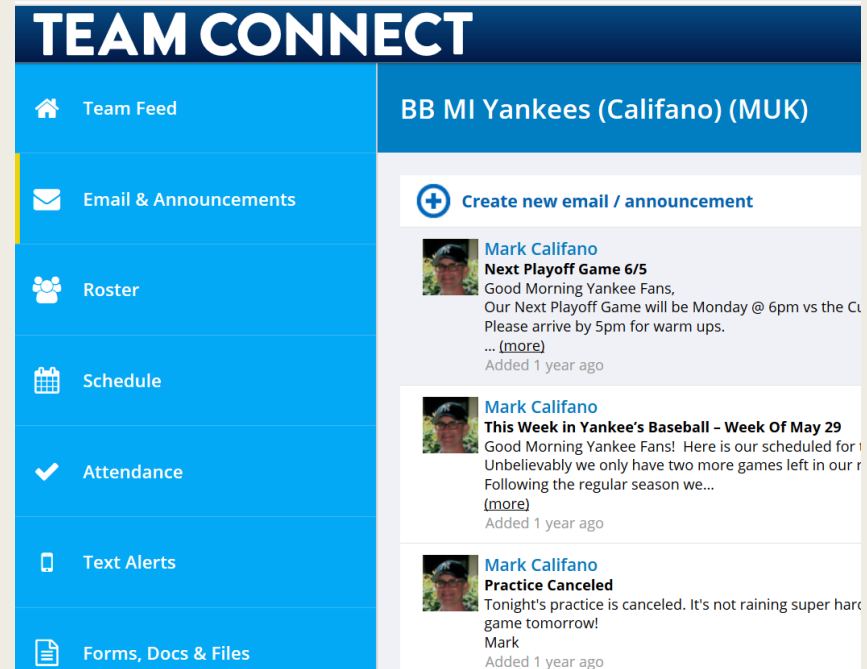
Fields and Practice Locations



- All Families are encouraged to contribute & volunteer for the league.
