Not Allowed (Umpire inspect before each game)

- Helmets with Torn or missing padding
- Cracked or Altered Helmets
- Non-Little League Approved Bats
- Dented, Cracked or Altered Bats

* All biological Males are required to wear a safety cup

** League has batting helmets that players can sign out for the season. Coaches will have a limited number of team helmets.



Bat Specifications

Little League Approved Bats (USABat Standard)

- Tee Ball – 26-inches or Less
 - USA Baseball Stamp with text “Only For Use With Approved Tee Balls”
- Baseball – 2-1/4-in | 2-1/2-in | 2-5/8-in Barrel. 33-inches or Less
 - USA Baseball Stamp for Wood/Composite/Aluminum
 - Approved Tee Ball Bats Allowed
- Softball – 2-1/4-in Barrel. 33-inches or Less
 - USSSA BPF 1.20 ‘Softball’ or ‘Fastpitch Only’ Stamp

Fields and Practice Locations


Mukilteo Little League Complex

- Located in Paine Field Community Park on Beverly Park Road
- 2 Baseball, 1 Softball & 1 Tee Ball Field
- MLL pays for the maintenance of the Complex

Mukilteo School District School Fields

- Most practices are at school fields
- Mukilteo School District maintains these fields
- MLL pays rental fees and for Honey Buckets
- Coaches pick practice fields and times
 - Priority goes to higher levels. Tee Ball gets last pick of practice times and locations*

*Exception being MLL Complex Tee Ball Field. Priority for Tee Ball Teams.


