Code of Conduct

This code of conduct is in effect for all games, practices, and league functions. All managers, coaches, players, and parents (or guardians) are required to read and sign this code. In doing so, you will be acknowledging that you agree to comply with this code. Any infractions will be taken before the Board of Directors for resolution. This could result in the removal of a manager or coach or expulsion from the league if warranted. The following code of conduct will pertain to all parents, players, league officials, umpires, and spectators.

There will be no profane, vulgar, or obscene language by any representative of the league, any parent, or any player.

There will be no gambling or betting at league facilities and no betting on the outcome of any games, at any time.

There will be no physical confrontations (e.g. pushing, poking, spitting, or hitting), attacks, or threats of attacks, against any player, parent, spectator, coach, manager, umpire, official, or board member.

There will be no unnecessarily rough play against any player during the course of a game or practice.

There will be no verbal abuse of umpires by players, parents, spectators, coaches, managers, or league officials.

There will be no obnoxious or objectionable displays of anger about any decision by an umpire, including but not limited to the throwing of equipment (hats, bats, balls, gloves, or helmets), swearing, yelling, kicking, insulting, or any physical confrontation.

There will be a zero-tolerance policy for anyone showing up at league fields under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Intoxication will be determined by an objectionable behavior and/or odor of alcohol. Authorities will be called. Alcohol is not allowed at any Little League function including games and practices.

Umpires will not be challenged. Umpires have the right and the authority to discipline any offender, including having them removed from the park or league facilities.

No cigarettes, e-cigarettes, alcohol, or illegal substances are permitted in any park. There will be no smoking at or near any field during any Little League function.

There will be no manipulation of any league rulebooks, rosters, or scorebooks, by anyone at any time.
