Playmakers Adult Cornhole Rules

For Tribal League Use — Standardized for Community Recreation

Game Format

- Teams: 2 players per team
- Match: Best of 3 games
- Game to: 21 points (no bust rule)

Game Play

- Boards placed: 27 feet apart front-to-front (official distance)
- Bag toss: Teams alternate tossing all 4 bags each
- One round: 8 total bags tossed (4 per player)

Scoring

- 3 points = Bag in the hole
- 1 point = Bag on the board
- 0 points = Bag on the ground or bounced onto board
- Cancellation scoring: Only the net difference in points counts per round
- Example: Team A scores 8, Team B scores 5 → Team A earns 3 points

Turn Order

- First toss of game is determined by coin flip
- After that, team with most points in previous round tosses first
- If tied, last round's toss order continues

Fouls

- Stepping past the front edge of the board (foul line)
- Throwing out of turn
- Throwing with improper foot placement
- Bags not delivered within 20 seconds of start of turn
- Penalty: Bag is forfeited for that throw

Player Conduct

- No profanity, taunting, or physical interference
- Keep a positive and respectful environment
- Alcohol policy based on host community center's rules

Winning the Match

- First team to win 2 out of 3 games wins the match
- Games can be shortened in bracket-style tournaments if time requires

Tiebreaker (Tournament Use)

- If teams are tied in standings, use:
- 1. Head-to-head
- 2. Total point differential
- 3. Coin toss

Equipment

- Boards: 2 feet x 4 feet regulation cornhole boards
- Bags: 16 oz. (1 lb.) filled with resin or corn
- All equipment will be provided by the league unless otherwise approved
