

Missouri City Little League Sponsorship Agreement

This agreement between the Missouri City Little L	eague (hereinafter, "Local Little League") and		
	(hereinafter, "Sponsor") is for the upcoming		
season.			

Sponsorship of the Local Little League must be, for the Sponsor, out of a sense of duty to help the community. While Sponsorship does afford some benefits (detailed below), the higher purpose is to help the Local Little League impart the values of teamwork, sportsmanship, and fair play to the children of the community, so that they may someday use these values in becoming good citizens.

Sponsorship of the Local Little League does not permit the Sponsor to have any rights or responsibilities in the operation of the Local Little League or any team in the Local Little League, nor does the Sponsor have any rights or responsibilities in the selection of managers, coaches or players for any team in the Local Little League. Nothing herein shall make us partners or joint ventures. The Sponsor and the Local Little League are independent contractors with respect to one another, and neither shall have any authority to represent or bind the other in any manner or to any extent whatsoever, except as specified herein.

Any reference to the Sponsorship under this agreement must make it clear that the Sponsorship is with the Local Little League ONLY, and NOT with Little League Baseball and Softball, the organization. Use of the marks of logos of Little League Baseball and Softball by any local sponsor is prohibited, unless permission is expressly granted in writing by Little League Baseball, Incorporated.

The Local Little League agrees to provide the following benefits in exchange for the

Dear Mr. Madson:

This letter is to inform you that the Missouri City Little League of Missouri City, Texas, is a chartered member of Little League Baseball, Incorporated, and having added EIN 88-3210005 to our group effective this date, is now covered under our Federal Group Tax Exemption Number 3158 as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Enclosed is a copy of the IRS Letter of Determination that should be presented along with this letter to any donor that requests proof of your federal tax-exempt status. This tax-exempt status applies only to chartered Little League programs.

As a reminder, as part of the requirements set forth by the IRS, all leagues listed under our group number must submit yearly financial statements to Little League International, utilize the same fiscal year as Little League Baseball, Incorporated, which is 10/1 - 9/30 and file the appropriate 990 Form with the IRS annually to retain their tax-exempt status. Failure to timely file the required IRS form annually could result in your organization losing its federal tax-exempt status.

This is in response to your request dated June 24, 2019, for information about your tax-exempt status.

Our records indicate we issued a determination letter to you in May 1981, and you're currently exempt under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c)(3).

We also recognized the subordinates on the list you submitted as exempt from federal income tax under IRC Section 501(c)(3).

For federal income tax purposes, donors can deduct contributions they make to you as provided in IRC Section 170. You're also qualified to receive tax deductible bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts under IRC Sections 2055, 2106 and 2522.

Because IRC Section 170(c) describes your subordinate organizations, donors can deduct contributions they make to them.

Please refer to www.irs.gov/charities for information about filing requirements. Specifically, IRC Section 6033(j) provides that, if you don't file a required return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked on the filing due date of the third required return or notice.

In addition, each subordinate organization is subject to automatic revocation if it doesn't file a required return or notice for three consecutive years. Subordinate organizations can file required returns or notices individually or as part of a group return.
