

2022 Regular Season Site Director Duties

1. Please arrive on time for your shift, which is scheduled for 30 minutes before the first game start time (for weekday games). Write your name and cell phone number on the dry erase board under "Site director on duty is: " in the Plaskowitz and Roche snack stands
 2. If snack stands/score boxes are locked, check the schedule and contact the eboard member who signed up to open that day.
 3. Notify managers on all fields that you are the site director and let them know you will be available if they need anything.
 4. Ensure snack stands are being covered by the parents of the home team. If not, find the home team manager and direct him to provide coverage. If parents are not available for coverage, he or one of his coaches must work the stand.
 5. Make sure the hardball/softball rules are being followed.
 6. If there is a dispute regarding a rule, you may be involved in making a decision. Please reference the rule book that is available in each snack stand for answers.
 7. If there is an emergency you are the point person. EMS/police (203- 891-2130) should be called immediately.
 8. If there is bad weather you may be involved in making the decision as to whether to continue or stop play. Consult with the managers and umpires to determine best course of action. See lightning guidelines from Little League below. The goal is to play the game if players safety will not be jeopardized. If you hear thunder or observe threatening skies, immediate action is required! It is not safe to be outside when lightning is in your area. Dugouts and pavilions do not provide safe cover during thunderstorms, and never seek shelter under a picnic shelter, under bleachers, or in a shed.
- When lightning threatens, seek safety in a sturdy building that has plumbing and electricity. If this isn't an option, seek shelter in a hard-topped vehicle with the windows up. While in the vehicle, don't touch anything metal, or any electronics. It is safe to head back to the field 30 minutes after the thunder and lightning come to an end.
