#### Season Timeline:

• Week of 2/20: Hold Majors and Easterns manager interviews, if necessary

- 3/1: Majors/Easterns/Call up requests evaluations at The Grind
- Week of 3/4: Conduct Majors draft first and then Easterns
- Week of 3/10
  - Post Majors/Easterns rosters/have managers reach out to their teams
  - Conduct casual Rookies draft
    - Goal is to have 4 teams for Rookies division
  - Put coach pitch and t-ball teams together
    - Requests to play with friends will be honored in coach pitch and t-ball. If already registered and did not enter anything in that field, reach out to OLL email so we can align
- 3/17: All rosters established so equipment manager can get uniform orders in with 4 week lead time
- 4/1: 1<sup>st</sup> day to book fields for practice
  - Call the town to book school fields or High Plains. Old Tavern will be used in priority order (Majors, Easterns). Best bet is to book town fields by calling the town.
  - T-ball assign a day for practices at Old Tavern using Clementine field or team manager will book through the town

#### Other Notable Dates:

- 4/4: Coaches meeting, requirement for coaches and managers.
  - AED and safety protocols will be discussed
  - Structure of league and coaching tips
  - Gamechanger and scorekeepers
- Spring Break is Week of 4/15, no games but practices can be held if not traveling
- Start games on 4/22, not every team will play but this is when all levels will start
  - o 12 games played in 6 weeks, one game during the week and one game on Saturday
  - Schedule will allow for 7 weeks and will go through Memorial Day in case of make ups
  - Will not schedule games after school ends
  - Playoff format for Majors and Easterns, games could be 3 days a week to stay on schedule

#### Opening Day:

- 4/27 opening day ceremony
  - On field team announcements
  - o Food and baseball type games
  - Some teams will play in the afternoon time slot
- T-ball will have their own ceremony likely the following week

## Field Improvements:

- Request will be put into the town to put more dirt on MLT pitching mound
- Grass is being grown out on T-ball field to look more like a baseball field. Field/baselines have been cut out to allow for proper growing
- Spring clean up day is generally in early April. Will get more details from Dino at next meeting.

- Good opportunity for OLL parents to get involved
- 4 batting cages available for use, will need netting put up
- Leaf blowing, clean up dugouts/bathrooms

## Other Topics Discussed:

- Practices are expected but can vary by each level. Recommendation is 2 practices a week before the season starts, then 1 practice during the season.
- Goal is to have someone appointed at each level as your go to contact person. Able to go to them first with any questions, then can reach out to E-board members if necessary.
- Draft process: Team managers will get together in a room after evaluations take place
  - Manager's child skill level needs to be determined based on ranking system. Once that draft slot is determined, it then works like a typical snake draft
  - o Majors: 12 year olds will go first, then 11 year olds go next.
  - Easterns takes on same draft process
- USA bat required, no USSSA bats. Check before games to make sure teams are using proper equipment
- Umpires and scorekeepers have a tough job. Treat them with respect. Umpire will always have the authority during games
- GameChanger live streaming was mentioned. We have the capability to do it and will be looked into. Possibly have a holder for tablet/cell phone behind home plate to live stream.
