Levels of hardball and District 4 Little League

- Tball, Coach Pitch, Rookies, Minors and Majors
- Age of player will be determined as of August 31, 2026
- Orange is in District 4. Two Bridgeport teams will be added this year to the district and Stratford as well

2025 Fall Season Recap

- We tried the district Majors/Minors program this year
  - 1 Orange team for Majors and 1 Orange team for Minors
  - Games were played Saturday and Sunday at Old Tavern and at other teams in our district
- Coach Pitch and Tball stayed in Orange as in previous years since registration is higher in the lower levels. Games on Saturday/Sunday.
  - Coach Pitch teams resulted in higher than normal of players per team. Our goal is to keep the teams between 7-10 players. A lot of late registrations came in resulting in higher numbers of players per team.

2026 Spring Season

- Start games: April 20th after Spring Break
  - 12 games over approximately 6-7 weeks – weather dependent
  - One game during the week and one on Saturday
  - Sunday stay open so kids can play other sports
  - Try not to have games past last day of school but school is ending on the 6/9 so may have to go over in the younger levels
- Opening Day Ceremonies: April 25th

- Looking for volunteers to help with opening day festivities
- Forms committee for volunteers to help coordinate the day
- Amity High School typically will volunteer to run stations for the kids
- T-ball was incorporated with one opening day rather than have separate one and it seemed to go well

#### Registration

- Registration opening end of December/early January
- Email blast will go out and posts on social media
- Looking to engage with Parks and Rec for basketball season so they can send out an email blast to register for the spring season
- Signs will be placed around town in high traffic areas and at schools
- Registration is open to Orange/Bethany/Woodbridge residents
- New Little League International rule last year that players aged 4-7 may play for any town
  - Might get registration from surrounding towns that might not have strong registration numbers
- Registration will close end of February
- Always looking for coaches/managers especially at the lower levels.
  - Encourage anyone thinking about managing to take a look at the videos posted on the OLL website or ask around for feedback on managing
  - Encourage requests for friends that would like to play together at the lower level
  - Can't do this at the upper levels since there is a draft process

#### Improvements

- Encourage volunteers to come out in the spring to help with field improvements to get everything ready for the spring
- Renovations done to the infield and mound on Roche
  - New clay and sod put down, field looks great
  - Last year updates included dugout renovations on Goldberg/Roche, new backstop on Roche, complex re keyed and fix fencing all around the complex
  - Will look for more improvements for the spring season
