

# PLL Field Policies & Procedures

## A Quick Guide for Managers & Coaches

This guide is written for **volunteer managers and coaches** for all the fields utilized by Pacific Little League. Please **read before each game**, especially if you are at an unfamiliar location. Failure to adhere to these policies & procedures may result in loss of practice fields and up to suspension from a game.

### ALL FIELDS — GENERAL RULES (APPLY EVERYWHERE)

#### NOT ALLOWED

- Sunflower seeds, tobacco, vaping products, or gum
- Glass containers or sharp objects
- Weapons of any kind (bats are enough)

#### REQUIRED

- Leave dugouts, fields, cages, and facilities **cleaner than you found them**
- Show good sportsmanship to players, coaches, umpires, and fans
- Have **FUN!**

### EVERGREEN BALL PARK

#### Before the Game

- Field is usually chalked and set up by Evergreen Facilities
- **Set up the pitching mound**
  - Stored in **Stairwell Storage**
  - Door code: **2902**

#### After the Game

5:00 / 5:30 PM Games

- Clean and tidy dugouts

7:00 / 7:30 PM Games

- Clean and tidy dugouts
  - **Players stay until this is done**
- Put pitching mound back in **Stairwell Storage**
  - Door must be **closed and locked**

#### Important Notes

- Breakaway bases belong to Evergreen, not PLL
  - **Leave bases on the field**
  - Evergreen will rake and handle bases later
- **Do NOT** access the upstairs / crow's nest

- **Do NOT** use generators or large batteries for pitching machines or other equipment
- **Do NOT** use loudspeakers or noise makers

## LYNNDALE BALL PARK

### Before the Game

- Rake / drag the infield
- Chalk base paths and batter's box
- Roll (preferred) or fold tarp neatly outside of the field and place on top or close to the jobox

### After the Game

#### 5:00 PM Games

- Clean and tidy dugouts
  - **Players stay until this is done**

#### 7:00 PM Games

- Clean and tidy dugouts
  - **Players stay until this is done**
- Rake infield, mound, and home plate area
- Roll out tarp on F1 & F2 utilizing the tent pegs to help keep in place
- Put away all field equipment
  - Bases, pitching plates (F2), etc.
  - Store in **joboxes** and **lock them**

## ESD & EDMONDS CITY PARKS

### Before the Game

- Rake / drag the infield
- Chalk base paths and batter's box
- Set up pitching mound or plate

### After the Game

- Clean and tidy dugouts
  - **Players stay until this is done**
- Rake infield, mound, and home plate area
- Put away all field equipment
  - Bases, pitching plates (F2), etc.
  - Store in **joboxes** and **lock them**

### Important Notes

- **Do NOT** use generators or large batteries to run pitching machines at any school district field
- **Do NOT** use loudspeakers or noise makers

- Clean and tidy dugouts
