RLL Goals and Visions – Board, Coaches & Volunteers

- 1. Provide players with playing time at multiple positions throughout the season.
- 2. Dedicate practice time each week for continuous work on the 'little things.'
- 3. Take away playing time for poor sportsmanship, disrespect, poor choices and explain why.
- 4. Promote thought and encourage passion. Be open to feedback and listen to your players.
- 5. Consistently promote self-evaluation/reflection. Ask your players questions and look for feedback.
- 6. Rotate pitchers consistently in Major/Minor/AA divisions. Ensure they're consistently developing/refining their delivery and staying safe & healthy with proper techniques and mechanics.
- 7. When mistakes are made, focus on positive first. Rebuild their confidence and send them back onto the field.
- 8. Excellence in areas of sportsmanship, respect, leadership and positivity need to be created by the coaches. Don't create a division amongst players, parents, and coaches where one group of players is treated differently than another group of players due to talent, skills, and/or who their parents are.
- 9. Create a team full of future leaders, FLOR (Future Leaders of Ridgefield) Some of these kids may end up being your future boss. Let that one sink in.
- 10. Lead by example. Motivate, inspire, and encourage these young kids to act as leaders among their peers, their opponents, the umpires, ALL fans, away from the field, at home, and in the classroom. We have the responsibility to show them this behavior every time we're together whether practicing or playing a game. Be a great example of how to carry yourself in moments of adversity and moments of greatness. These kids will hopefully not only remember but cherish these times the rest of their lives!

- Need for Umpires BB & SB Ask parents to volunteer, RLL will schedule umpires as available.
- All-Star eligibility/availability Coaches & Players to be eligible need to submit requests and documents to the League by May 27th 2022

 - Players need to submit eligibility request and documents including School verification forms signed by the school administrator or the 3 identification methods and signed All-Star form player form to be added to the ballot.
