Game Times

- We will follow the same fields and time slots *WITH THE ADDITION* of 1:15pm games
 - Needed during Rd. 1 (wk 6) and Rd. 2 (wk. 7) to complete the bracket within the three weeks.
- Grades and game times
 - During the playoffs, the grade level "normal" gametimes **WILL CHANGE**.
 - This is needed for bracket flow and ensure all playoff games conclude on our Championship Monday Night.

Outline

- All teams make the playoffs.
 - Standings based off of regular season record
- Game order follows a 12 or 14 Team Consolation Bracket
- Some teams will have to play double headers (two games one Sunday)
 - You will ALWAYS have at least ONE game per playoff week
 - Some teams will have double headers
 - Teams with potential double header will have a star on the schedule
 - If you win first game you play second game next time slot
 - All double headers will be the next game on same field
- **PLAYOFFS ARE DOUBLE ELIMINATION WITH CONSOLATION**
 - **No playoff losses = NFFL Championship**
 - No losses in playoffs would bring you to the Championship Monday Night Game (11/3)
 - **1 playoff loss = President's Cup Championship**
 - If you lose in Rd. 1 or Rd. 2, the Team still has the chance to win 3rd Place - President's Cup Game Monday Night (11/4)
 - **2 playoff losses = Round 3 Consolation Game (11/2) → last game of season**
 - If you lose in Rd. 1 and then again in Rd. 2 - *YOU STILL PLAY ROUND 3 (11/2)*.
 - This is a consolation game, and teams will play another team that has lost twice before round 3
