

South Fayette Soccer Fall 2023 registration runs from May 1-31, 2023

SFSA registration for the Fall 2023 soccer season opens on May 1 and will run through the month of May. Register now at <u>southfayettesoccer.org</u> by clicking the Login or Register button in the top right of the page.

*SFSA will also hold a virtual meeting and Q&A session about the Travel Program for parents of upcoming U10 players and other new players to help parents decide if the travel program may be a good fit for their child. Please stay tuned for more information.

New during this registration period: During the May 2023 registration period, parents will be asked to volunteer for one of the following roles or pay a \$50 non-volunteer fee (one per family):

- Coaching (head or assistant)
- Field lining (time commitment 2-3 hours per season, training will be provided)
- Age group coordinators (creating teams, scheduling, communicating with coaches)
- South Fayette Soccer Association support for board activities such as registration, communications, uniforms, Picture Day, web site, volunteer coordination, etc. (time commitment - 1-5 hours per month)
- Referee in the family (must be active in our system or a credentialed travel referee)

*Please note that SFSA is a volunteer-run organization with upwards of 600 players. It requires coordination of players, coaches and teams, coordination of fields with the township, registration of players and coaches with PA West, ordering equipment and uniforms, and many other activities and duties. As the organization grows and as board members' and coaches' kids age out of the organization, we must be able to replenish the help that prior volunteers have provided. Please consider volunteering your time to help the organization run smoothly.

Uniforms

Players in the Travel Program must own a SFSA travel uniform kit to play in the Fall 2023 season. Click here for <u>detailed information about Travel Uniforms</u>.

• If you purchased a uniform kit for the Fall 2022 or Spring 2023 seasons, you do NOT need to purchase another one unless a player is missing or has outgrown a piece. (You



may buy extra pieces while the uniform store is open during registration. We will also be offering a new shorts option with a more desirable soccer fit.)

- If you are new to the program or did not purchase a Travel uniform for the Fall 2022 or Spring 2023 seasons, you will need to purchase one uniform per player in the travel program. More information will be provided closer to May.
- Players in the In-House Program do not need to purchase a uniform.

Travel Evaluations

Players who are considering registering for the Travel Program must participate in at least one evaluation session in Spring 2023 held in May. If a player registers for the Travel program and did not participate in an evaluation session, a parent will be asked to petition the board for an exception in order to be placed on a team.
