We will use a different program this year in which we hope to train <u>before the season starts</u> as to not disrupt in season practices. There will be 6 stations where the kids will rotate every 15 minutes for 1.5 hours. The downside here is that we won't be able to build on skills per week, but we are looking for a way to convey the most basic concepts of soccer at this age and to have a baseline for all coaches to start from.

After DJ DiMarco researched several options, the board has approved the following plan:

Pittsburgh Soccer Academy (https://pittsburghsocceracademy.com) will conduct training prior to season start.

- Pittsburgh Soccer Academy (PSA) would run 2 training dates March 19 or 20 and March 26 or 27. South Fayette soccer would give use of Preservation Park field group A for the above dates.
- PSA would supply equipment (cones/minigoals). PSA would also supply 6 trainers for 3
 hours at each training date. 1.5 hours would be allotted for training of the girls and 1.5
 hours for the boys.
- The cost of the trainers would be \$75/hour. Cost per trainer for 2 sessions would be (6 hours x\$75)= \$450. \$450 x 6 trainers=\$2,700 to be paid by South Fayette Soccer Association.
- PSA would be responsible for planning and running 6 individual drills for each session to include dribbling, receiving, passing, shooting, game play, activation & agility with a focus on basic skills. The two sessions will each have 6 different drills for a total of 12 drills.
- SF u8 coaches should attend and learn from the sessions. PSA will allow SF u8 coaches to be on field to participate and ask questions. SFSA will be responsible for organizing kids into groups of 15 or less.
- o Follow-ups:
 - How to plan for weather issues. Options if fields are closed (dates in April? cancel program?)
 - Make sure we have the field for those dates?
 - Total numbers for u8?
 - Did we get enough head coaches to sign up? Will we have commitment from coaches to attend? Will board members need to assure that there will be enough coaches there, since this is outside scheduled practice times?
 - Book dates soon since PSA trains Mt. Lebo, Peters, South Park, and Thomas Jefferson. Dates and times preferred?
 - If training sessions go well, plan to use PSA for travel evaluations in May/June.
