Weather Policy

Rain, Thunderstorms and Lightening

At Girls Play Flag Football, the safety of our players, coaches, and spectators is of utmost importance. We have established the following weather policy to ensure everyone's well-being during flag football games and events:

Rain: We understand that rain can be part of the game, and as long as there is **NO** lightning present, games will proceed as scheduled. In the case of rain, we recommend players come prepared with appropriate rain gear (e.g., waterproof jackets, hats) and suitable footwear for wet conditions. Please note that if field conditions become unsafe or unplayable due to heavy rain, the league organizers will make a decision and communicate any necessary delays or cancellations.

Thunderstorms and Lightning: Safety is our top priority, and we adhere to a strict policy when it comes to thunderstorms and lightning. If thunder is heard or lightning is seen within a 10-mile radius of the field, all activities will be immediately suspended. In such cases, players, coaches, and spectators must seek shelter indoors or in a designated safe area until it is deemed safe to resume activities.

Communication: In situations where weather conditions may impact game schedules or activities, we will provide timely updates through our official communication channels. It is important for all participants and spectators to check for updates on our website, social media platforms, or through the communication method specified by the league.

Delayed Games: In the event of inclement weather, we may implement a delay of up to 30 minutes to allow for weather conditions to improve. If the delay exceeds 30 minutes, subsequent games may experience adjusted start times. Your patience and understanding are greatly appreciated as we navigate through any weather-related challenges.

Please remember that our weather policy is in place to ensure the safety and well-being of all involved. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we prioritize the welfare of our players, coaches, and spectators.
