



## SRHL Rink Rules

### Outside:

- Park in MARKED PARKING SPOTS only. There are parking spots immediately outside the rink doors. If those spots are full, there is additional parking outside the gate.
- Drive cautiously through the parking lot and watch for pedestrians. The speed limit is 10 mph throughout the fairgrounds.
- Please supervise your children when outside. Remember that we are renting this facility. Any damage to the fairgrounds or issues that arise are at a cost to the league and could affect our lease for the next season.

### Inside:

- Only Registered Players, Coaches, Referees, and Volunteers are allowed on the rink to participate in games, practices, and clinics. Individuals who are not a registered SRHL member are to remain off the rink.
- No climbing the rails or playing underneath the stands.
- Please clean up your trash when leaving. There is no cleaning service provided by the fairgrounds.
- The player boxes on the north side of the rink are for players and coaches only. Parents and siblings are not allowed to sit in this area.
- The rink door is to remain closed at all times when there are activities occurring on the rink, except in the case of players, referees, or coaches entering or exiting the rink.
- No food or drink on the rink at any time.
- Clean up all spills immediately. Spills are a slipping hazard.
- The bathroom hallway is not a playroom for children. Please explain this to your child.
- The Goalie Room is off limits except to coaches, referees, board members, and goalies. This is not a playroom, and the equipment is not for children to play with.
- For their own safety, players must be fully outfitted in all required gear before entering the rink.
- The Home Team of the last game each night, is responsible for basic clean up of the facility before leaving. This includes sweeping stands, sweeping the floor around and under the stands, cleaning the bathrooms, picking up and dumping all trash in the dumpster outside.

- Respect coaches, referees, and players. Derogatory and disrespectful comments should be kept to yourself unless there is a true issue of player safety. Remember that kids are out there to play and have fun. Coaches and referees are volunteers and are necessary to run a successful season. If you feel you can do a better job, we encourage you to speak to a board member or coordinator about volunteering your time.
- Please supervise your children inside. Although it may be fun for them to play with their friends, causing chaos by running in and out of doors, skating into people, screaming, and fighting is not appreciated by all visitors. If your child is causing an issue, he/she may be asked to leave the facility. Continued disrespect of the SRHL rules may result in being banned from the facility for the season.
