
Exact training and match times will be announced upon arrival.

The tour includes 7-nights accommodations and breakfast daily at the 3-star The Student Hotel, offering modern hospitality in a renovated stunning 19th century palazzo. Inside you will find an incredible concept restaurant and bar, rooftop gym, pool, and skybar with views of the city. The hotel is within walking/biking distance to the historic city center, museums, and the central train station. A tram stop is located across the street

All rooms are air conditioned with a Queen-size bed and in-suite bathroom, flatscreen television, free wifi, and Nespresso coffee machine.
