

MAJOR/MINOR BASEBALL PITCHING RULES

PITCH COUNT RULES

<u>AGE</u>	<u>MAX # PITCHES PER GAME</u>
11-12	85
9-10	75
6-8	50

REST REQUIREMENTS

<u># PITCHES</u>	<u>REQUIRED CALENDAR DAYS REST</u>
1-20	0
21-35	1
36-50	2
51-65	3
66 OR MORE	4

A pitcher reaching the maximum # of pitches while facing a batter, can complete the at-bat.

A player cannot pitch in more than one game in a calendar day.

A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play catcher for the remainder of that day.

If a pitcher reaches 40 pitches while facing a batter, they can complete the at-bat and still be eligible to catch that day.

A player who has played the position of catcher in 4 or more innings cannot pitch on that calendar day.

Managers and coaches can warm up pitchers.
