Minutes of the Meeting of Board of Directors

Wednesday, March 12, 2025

The Munster Little League met in regular session on Wednesday, March 12, 2025 via Zoom Meeting in Munster, Indiana. The meeting opened at 7:02 pm. The purpose of the meeting was to conduct regular business.

- I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by President J. Castellano at 7:02 pm. A quorum was present.

IV. Reports -

President Report – J. Castellano – Evaluations and drafts are done. Getting lots of info out to families- sending emails and answering Facebook posts.

Treasurer Report - D. Panaggio-

- Approved capital improvements via email. We are in a good position to do that at this time. The original cost was going to be \$10K, but now will only be \$6500.
- We were conservative with our estimates, but John won another \$5K award from US Steel! We will put it towards the capital improvements (C Field). The town will be covering the improvements to A, B and D fields.
- If we ever need to tighten the budget, there are places we can cut the fat. We are bringing in a lot of income right now. There continues to be more kids signing up. If there are big expenses still outstanding, let him know. Lansing still has not sent more than one invoice at this point.
- Went through an audit on our workers comp insurance. There is a one time \$400 cost because the 1099 to the umpires was counted as wages. Rick is now restructured as a corporation- so we will not have to 1099 him anymore.

X. Scheduling/Uniforms/Opening Day

Scheduling- A. Rubio

- # of games: 16 Majors, 16 Minors; 14 C League; 10 for Prep and TBall.
- Will have some Fridays and Saturdays for Majors and Minors, more for C League
- -Majors- Mon/Wed; all set up, needs to be audited
- -Minors- Tues/Thurs- all set up, needs to be audited
- -C League- Mon-Thurs, some Saturdays
- -Prep/Tball- Saturdays until school lets out; then add some during the week; These 2 divisions will play on Mother's Day weekend
- -Hoping to be wrapped up (regular season and tournaments) by 6/21 for Majors and Minors; Wrap up C League the week after

Uniforms: R. Rommelfanger

- All Majors, Minors and C League uniforms have been ordered-sent to vendor; hats are in (or back ordered ones will be shipped by EOW)
- Once in, we'll set a date for pickup at the press box
- LL patches have been ordered; will take to Lansing when they arrive to be added to the jerseys

Opening Day

- -Soft start- week of 4/21
- -League opening day is Sat, 5/3- push ceremonies back until 12:30 (instead of 12p)
- -Rob Kinsella has agreed to throw out the first pitch to open the season
- -Presentation of District Champion team banners; and State Champion banners $\,$
- -MGS reached out to see if we would go in for half of a Rainbow Cone truck to be there on opening day; \$1500 total cost- worth the money? Could be a bad weather day and opening day is already very busy- might not be worth it.
- -Will reach out Tom's Traveling Coffee Truck; Donut IV Truck to check availability and pricing

XI. District 1 Meeting

- -Short meeting;
- -Gave an idea of when tournaments will start- based on last year; 12s, then 10s, then 11s- staggered start; State start dates are on the Indiana State Tournament website
- -Draws will be in April; will announce them June 1st
- -State Park is not hosting 10s District Tournament; Hessville will host the Red Pool; he will move someone from the White pool to Hessville

XII. Spring Cleanup Day -

- -April 5th, 9a-12p; grounds crew has been informed (5 current members)
- -Batting cages might get set up by this weekend- depends on if the town gets to them.
- -Garbage bags, clippers, zip ties, ladders- have people bring their own equipment as well to make the work easier
- -Send league wide email with date of field cleanup

XIII. Equipment Update - J.Castellano -

- -Both parts of our DSG have come in; \$1K is to be used back at the store for equipment.
- -Will purchase what Brett shared in last month's meeting. Now that the money has come in, we can place the order

through the DSG Lockeroo

- -First aid kits ordered (smaller ones for TBall and Prep); larger kits for C, Minors and Majors
- -New equipment bags ordered- some smaller ones as well
- -Catcher's mask guards and Tees still need to be purchased; catcher's mitts for Minors and Majors- can use the DSG money
- -When do we hand out bags to managers? Anytime before April 1st is fine; or we hand out bags at spring cleanup day (April 5th)
- XIV. Umpires J. Castellano– John talked to Rick; He has been reaching out to umpires to get people locked in for this season. He knows the soft start date; knows that Majors and Minors will have 4 games Mon-Thurs.
 - No talk of raises this year

XV. Special Events - M. Bruni

- -talked about opening day events above
- -Talking to Up Your Alley about a LL day there
- -SB Cubs reached out- LL night 6/6; tickets are \$14 and we would get \$3 back per ticket
- -Already have Railcats game set- 5/31 (Firework night)
- -White Sox reached out- they put together an offer for us- May 4th game (v. Angels); set up a link to share with families- \$13 per ticket (\$4-6 surcharge from a 3rd party company). Kids can run around the bases after the game; if we get 250 people buying tickets, can get a parade on the field

XVI. Fundraising - J. Braatz-

- -Doing a good job getting last years sponsors signed again and invoiced for payment
- -A bunch of new sponsors as well! Have been dropping off sponsor letters at different businesses in the area; hoping to get more to sign as well!
- -Possibility to open up larger signs on the side of the batting cages facing the parking lot?? A lot of interest from companies to have the 16' banners.

XVII. New Business -

- -Plan to continue pizza parties for opening day banner winners
- -Get a picture taken of the whole league on opening day (by a drone)- will use the pic for a plaque for 2025 Sponsor Gifts -MHS Booster Club- Reverse Raffle on 4/25; will MLL donate a basket for a silent auction- DSG GC; A2000 Mitt? \$650 per tablecan buy a table for MLL or band together with friends to get a table;
