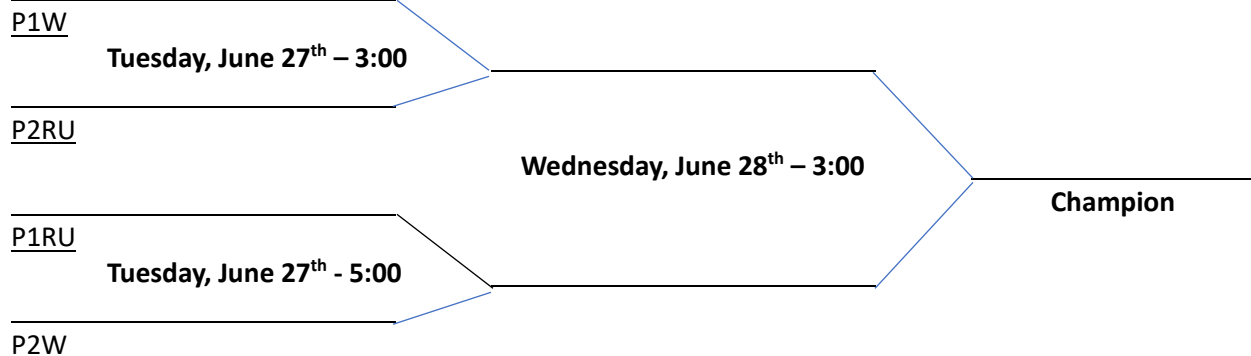

**District One Tournament Information**

- Continuous batting order – free substitutions on defense / mandatory play is to bat when rotation comes around.
- Coaches in dugouts – there may be 3 coaches in the dug-out max. One coach must remain in the dugout at all times, if there are only 2 you will need a player to coach a base.
- Catcher and pitcher substitution rules remain in place
  - Pitcher pitches 41 can't go to catcher
  - Catcher catches 4 innings can't go to pitcher (1<sup>st</sup> pitch of 4<sup>th</sup> inning counts as inning)
  - Catcher goes to pitcher and pitches 21, can't return to catcher
  - Thresholds apply at all levels
  - Pitcher removed from the mound may not return to pitch
- Mound visits
  - 1 visit to the same pitcher per inning and 2 per game – on 2<sup>nd</sup> visit in the same inning or third visit in the game the pitcher must be removed.
  - A visit to ANY defensive player is a visit to the pitcher
  - A visit to check on an injured player is not a visit, but may NOT be used to provide direction or coaching to any player.
- Extra innings – a game ending in a tie will play the 7<sup>th</sup> inning with no changes. Beginning with 8<sup>th</sup> inning a runner will be placed on 2<sup>nd</sup> base. That runner will be the player making the last out the previous inning.
- All games will be counted as 6 innings regardless on innings played for the purpose of using runs allowed tie breaker
- Pool play tie breakers
  - If 2 teams are tied the head-to-head will determine the victor
  - If 3 or more teams are tied, and no head-to-head determination can be made (i.e., neither team beat both the others), then the tie breaker will be determined by the least number of RUNS ALLOWED.
  - Once the runs allowed begins, it will be used to determine all places (i.e., do not return to head-to-head after the 1<sup>st</sup> place is determined)
