



First of all, thank you for considering joining the Bayside Pony Baseball league and letting your child play in the Bronco Division. Here are some things that will help you understand the division as we look forward to the 2020 season.

- ⑩ The official PONY rules and league by-laws addendum are posted on our website. The age cut-off date is 31 August 2019. If your player turns 11-years old before or 12 years of age after that date, they are eligible for BRONCO division.
- ⑩ Each team will have two weekday practices at our new facility at Luxford Elementary School.
- ⑩ As the division Vice President, I will ensure returning players are returned to their previous team. If your child is new to the league, division, they will have to go into a draft and try-outs will take place. Of course if you are a returning coach, your child will be on your team.
- ⑩ In the Bronco division, after returning players have been placed, the coaches and I will ensure each team is equitably drafted and formed.
- ⑩ The MLB and PONY have adopted pitch counts starting last season and is incorporated into Mustang and higher. The total pitch count per game is:

Age	Daily Max (Pitches in Game)	0 Days Rest	1 Day Rest	2 Days Rest	3 Days Rest	4 Days Rest
11-12	85	1-20	21-35	36-50	51-65	66+

- ⑩ Team coaches are aware of the rest requirement and as a parent you may want to also keep an idea of how many pitches your player throws per game and per week.

Uniforms

- ⑩ Team jerseys and hats are supplied by the league. Our current pants color is light gray.

Gear

- ⑩ Catcher's gear, several bats, and batting helmets are available for use. Usually, the player will have their own helmet, again, not a requirement as helmets are available.

Playing Time

- ⑩ The game will be seven innings. If the visiting team is leading by at least 10 runs at the end of 5 or more complete innings, the game shall be declared complete and the visiting team shall be declared the winner. If the home team is leading by at least 10 runs after the visiting team has completed batting in the 5th inning or later, the game shall be declared complete and the home team shall be declared the winner.
- ⑩ Players will get at least three innings of play per game, depending on player availability and time remaining in regulation, per the above paragraph.
- ⑩ In the case of inclement weather, the team manager/coach will notify parents of the game cancellation or postponement.
- ⑩ The Bronco division vice president will be available for questions and can be reached via the email address on the website, it is recommended that you work through the team manager/coach prior to reaching out to the vice president of the division or other board members.

As division vice president, I am committed to ensuring your child has a great season and learn the game of baseball, the camaraderie of being part of a team and the league he or she represents.
