

BU Hockey Camp - Sunscreen, Lip Balm, and Sun Exposure Policy

To protect campers from harmful sun exposure while participating in outdoor camp activities, BU Hockey Camp has adopted the following policies regarding sunscreen, lip balm, and sun safety:

1. Initial Application at Home:

Parents/guardians are responsible for applying the first layer of sunscreen before the camper arrives at camp each day.

2. Reapplication During Camp:

Campers may reapply sunscreen and lip balm throughout the day under the supervision of the Executive Director, Directors, Assistant Directors, or other trained camp staff.

3. Staff Assistance with Application:

Camp staff may only assist with the application of sunscreen or lip balm if the parent/guardian provides written permission below.

4. Supply Requirements:

Parents must provide sunscreen and lip balm for their child. Each item must be clearly labeled with the camper's first and last name and will be stored in the camper's designated group area.

5. Sun Protection Measures:

- Children will not be exposed to direct sunlight for prolonged periods.
- When sun exposure is anticipated, campers will be encouraged to wear hats and reapply sunscreen regularly.
- Whenever feasible, campers will be placed in shaded or covered areas to limit direct sun exposure.
