WHAT IS IT?

The Little League Challenger Division[®] was founded in 1989 and is Little League's adaptive baseball program for individuals with physical and intellectual challenges. Any individual with a physical or intellectual challenge may participate. If an individual can participate in the traditional Little League Baseball or Softball program with reasonable accommodations, they should do so. Challenger Little League focuses on the fundamental skills of baseball to include batting, throwing, catching and teamwork.

*PLAYERS:

* You do NOT need to be a Northmont School district resident to be eligible. This league is open to all local and surrounding school district residences. Any individual ages 4-18 (22 if still enrolled in school) with a physical or intellectual challenge may participate.

*BUDDIES:

- * Buddies assist players, but only as needed. Buddies assist players with batting, fielding, and running the bases.
- * Buddies should be at least 9yrs. of age.
- * High School students, Boy/Girl Scouts and other sports teams also make great Buddies.
