### **OHIO DISTRICT 8 TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1. Leagues not represented at the tournament draw meeting will not be allowed in the tournament.
- 2. All managers must attend the annual tournament draw meeting.
- 3. The League President or other appointed representative, will serve as Assistant Tournament Director at all home games and report to the district administrators. He/She will make themselves known to the umpire in chief and the visiting team manager and be responsible for fan deportment and game administration. There shall also be a board member from the visiting park who will make themselves known to the President of the home site.
- 4. All fields must have an outfield fence, public address system, scoreboard, *ADULT* scorekeepers, concessions and restroom facilities.
- 5. ALL FIELDS ARE NEUTRAL. Before each game, a single flip of a coin will be made with the winner getting choice of being home or visiting team OR choice of dugout. The loser will get the remaining choice.
- 6. Tournament format will be double elimination tournament.
- 7. *Game times* will be scheduled by the District Administrator and may be changed without notice.
- 8. ALL BACKSTOPS MUST BE DRAPED. No seating will be provided for fans in the area between the dugouts and the backstop unless this seating is permanent in nature.
- 9. Leagues hosting the games must provide at least six new game balls labeled "RS-T." The umpires must receive replenishment of new baseballs at their discretion.
- 10. The umpires will check all equipment prior to each game and give any illegal, defaced, or inadequate equipment to the tournament director. Any illegal equipment

brought into the game after this check is complete shall result in the removal of the player(s) using the equipment and the manager of the offending team.

- 11. If weather forces the ending of the tournament before all scheduled games are played, the loser's bracket will be dropped and the District will be represented by the team in the winner's bracket.
- 12. REGARDLESS OF THE WEATHER, both teams and umpires shall report to the game site. The home park will determine if the game can be played prior to the line-up exchange with the umpiring crew. Once the game begins, a determination of the fitness of the playing field is the sole judgment of the umpire and/or District Officials present.
- 13. If rain creates a "regulation game" situation, every effort must be made to finish the game. Umpires and District Officials at the game will ensure that the game is completed if there is a possibility to do so.
- 14. A game should not begin unless there is ample time to complete it.
- 15. Reports of verbal abuse to officials, umpires, or players could result in loss of home site privileges for the remainder of the tournament season and possible other sanctions as determined by the District Administrator.
- 16. ALL PLAYERS WILL BE IN A COMPLETE UNIFORM. This means that shirts must be tucked in and socks must be pulled up with no bare skin showing on the legs. Softball teams have the option of wearing hats for visors *OR* playing with no head covering. However, the entire team must be the same.
- 17. The traditional "pass the hat" will be passed at each tournament game. The proceeds shall be divided equally between the two teams to help offset tournament expenses.
- 18. Pitch Count shall be recorded by the official scorer, and his/her record shall be considered official in the event of a discrepancy. The announcer shall announce the total pitch count for each pitcher at the end of each half inning.

### 19. Game Preliminaries:

- a. The manager of each team shall complete a District Approval Line-Up Card and bring it to the Umpire-in-Chief during the Pre-Game Conference. This must be the original copy of the batting order. All changes and substitutions must go through he Umpire-in-Chief.
- b. Time Table before games:
  - i. 30 Minutes: Home Team Infield (Home as determined by coin toss).
  - ii. 20 Minutes: Visiting team Infield (Visitors as determined by coin toss).
  - iii. 15 Minutes: Equipment Check by Umpires.
  - iv. 10 Minutes: Pre-Game Conference with Umpires.
  - v. 5 Minutes: Announcements and National Anthem.

### 20. UMPIRES

- a. Each league will provide at least one umpire for baseball.
- b. Umpires must arrive at the game site at least 45 minutes prior to game time. Upon arrive, umpires must make themselves know to the tournament official.
- c. All umpires must be 18 year of age or older.
- d. For all baseball games, the home team (or park if applicable) will provide the plate umpire and the visiting team (or park if applicable) will provide the field umpire.
