### **Game Preparation**

- Lineups
  - 3 copies (scorekeeper, umpire, opposing manager)
  - Have them complete 30 minutes before game start
  - Don't worry if someone is not present they can easily be dropped and added to the end of the lineup if/when they arrive
  - Identify starting pitcher and catcher
- When umpire calls for teams to line up, stand on the foul lines with hats off and say LL pledge
- IMMEDIATELY after the conclusion of the pledge, manager should go to the plate meeting

## **During the Game**

- Stay inside the dugout during play not in the opening
- Call time and go to the umpire for a discussion don't have discussions through the fence
- One minute between innings clock starts from the last out of the previous half inning

#### After the Game

 It is your responsibility to have the umpire sign your pitching record
