

#### **Projected Budget for the 2023 Season**

#### **Expected Revenue**

Spring Flag Registration = \$13,800 (Estimate 120 flag players x \$115?)

Fall Flag/Tackle/Cheer Registration = \$42,900 (Estimate 220 children x \$195?)
Sponsorship \$19,500 (Estimate 13 teams fully sponsored @ \$1,500)

#### **Total Expected Revenue = \$76,200**

### Expected Expenses (Based on 2022 numbers with slight increases in costs)

Player Fees = \$7 per child (120 spring 220 fall) \$2380 Ref/SMYAC Fees = \$6800 Field Expenses = \$6000 Supplies/Materials (jerseys, pants, cheer packages, flags) \$23,000

Insurance = \$3500 Concession/Events Expenses = \$10,000 Helmet Reconditioning = \$4,000+

#### **Basic Total Projected Expenses = \$55,680**

This number only includes the largest expenses for the spring and fall seasons. (Refer back to 2022 financials for other costs)


