**Major Managers:**

- Your nominations for a 12 player roster for the 12 and under team
- Your nominations for a 12 player roster for the 11 and under team
- Your nominations for a 12 player roster for the 10 and under team (league age 10 who play in the Majors)

**Senior Managers**

- Your nominations for a 13 player roster- Senior team
- Your nominations for a 13 player roster- Junior team

**Junior Managers**

- Your nominations for a 13 player roster- Junior team
- Roster spots will be filled by Senior managers and if additional spots are needed, Junior manager's rosters will be considered

**The eligible players have been attached for you to view**

- Rules for choosing players:
  - If a player is nominated by three major managers / two senior managers, that player is automatically on the team
  - Remaining spots-
    - Will be filled by highest number of common votes at meeting
- All Star Meeting
  - Managers will submit their preliminary votes and then meet in person to finalize the teams.
  - Meeting Times/locations
    - Major Managers- 1:00 PM
    - Senior Managers- 2:30 PM
    - Junior Managers- 3:15 PM

- All Star Manager
  - Will be appointed by the board based on need and interest (those who filled out the Google form/Board Approved).
  - Little League is the priority, in terms of drafting a team (Majors/Minor players)

- **Managers will be provided with a hat and Drifit**
- Rules for acceptance on the All Star team-
  - Please email your teams ahead of time to make sure that players understand the expectations by saying that they should be able to commit to playing in the month of June and early July and pay \$100 (breakdown will be listed below, not to exceed \$150). They will also be required to show proof of residency and purchase a pair of pants, socks and a belt (color will be decided by the board). **The league wants every division to have the same uniform.**
- All Star announcements
  - We will publicly announce the All Star teams at closing ceremonies on May 30
  - After the selection process, please contact the parents to make sure that they can commit to the above criteria and get the player's size and number for their jersey and Drifit. It is important that they do not tell their child that they have made the team until it is announced on May 30
  - Players will receive their All Star hats at closing ceremonies
  - Players will take a group photo at closing ceremonies which will be submitted to be featured in the program
- All Star Paperwork
  - Managers need to collect specific information from parents to be verified by our player agent, president and district administrator.
- All Star practices/games
  - Teams can start practicing June 3
  - The first possible game date will be June 15
  - Teams should try to scrimmage with neighboring cities, outside of district 71. You may scrimmage with any team however, the district needs to be informed for insurance purposes.
- Breakdown of fees (as a reminder, the league pays for half the cost) \$100
