

Coach's Pay – Team Accounts

Coaches bill DRSC for training sessions and weekly games. A trainer's monthly hours are turned into the Director of Operation who then verifies them and makes payment.

Coaching Pay Scale

\$25 – College trainers

\$30 – USSF E license/ multi-year college trainer/ non-volunteer coach with playing & coaching experience

\$35 – USSF D license

\$40 – USSF C license/ NSCAA National Diploma

\$45 - USSF B license/ NSCAA Advanced National Diploma

\$50 - USSF A license / NSCAA Premiere Diploma

Coaches are paid the designated amount per session and per weekend non-tournament day, out of club coaching funds.

If a team has one league (non-tournament) game on Saturday – coach paid designated amount (same as training fee) from club.

Example:

If a college trainer coaches one game on Saturday – paid \$25. If a college trainer coaches two games on Saturday – paid \$50. If a college trainer coaches one game on Saturday & one on Sunday – paid \$50.

League Play

Club pays coaching fee for league games. For away games Team covers gas (.73/mile) and food (\$30/day) for coach.

Tournament Weekends

All the coach's/ trainer's expenses for a tournament should be taken care of by team: Hotel, gas (.73/mile), food (\$30/day), coaching (\$50/day).

Coach/Trainer

For a two day weekend tournament a trainer/coach should receive a per diem of \$60 (\$30 x 2 food), \$100 (\$50 X 2 coach), hotel, and gas.
