



## **CHARLOTTE SOCCER ACADEMY. UPDATED PLAYER AND SPECTATOR GUIDELINES.**

**The following guidelines will continue to be in effect for the start of the 2021-2022 season**

### **PLAYERS**

- If a player is experiencing any symptom of Covid-19, they must stay at home and contact the programs sectional director or their club coach.
- Players are not required to wear a face covering while on the fields OUTSIDE or on the sidelines.
- Players having games or sessions at an indoor facility are required to wear face coverings if they are NOT fully vaccinated.
- Players need to bring their own water (please bring enough for the entire game or session).
- Players should not take off any equipment until they have left the facility.

### **SPECTATORS**

- Spectators experiencing any symptom of Covid-19 must stay at home.
- Spectators will no longer be required to wear a face covering on the sidelines.
- Spectators on the sidelines are still encouraged to stay within your family group and continue to practice social distancing rules set forth by CDC and NC Department of Health guidelines (6 feet apart).

### **COACHES**

- If a coach is showing any symptoms of Covid-19 they must stay at home.
- Coaches will no longer be required to wear face coverings while coaching teams OUTSIDE on the fields.
- CSA is recommending those coaches who HAVE NOT been vaccinated to wear a face covering when coaching in practices and or games.
- Coaches conducting training sessions at an indoor facility will be required to face coverings.
- Coaches will be responsible for all equipment and continue to sanitize daily.
