As a manager or an assistant coach of West Sacramento Little League's Baseball program, I recognize that I have a significant impact on the players, parents, and the overall success of the league. I am committed to upholding the values of sportsmanship, fairness, and integrity. My behavior and actions should reflect the high standards expected in Little League, fostering a positive, educational, and enjoyable experience for all participants. I agree to adhere to the following Code of Conduct:

- 1. Commitment to the Development of Players I will strive to develop the skills, character, and confidence of every player, regardless of their ability level. I will create a positive environment that emphasizes teamwork, sportsmanship, and fun, where all players have the opportunity to learn and grow. I will treat each player with respect, ensuring that they feel valued, supported, and encouraged, both on and off the field.
- 2. Respect for Players I will not use physical, verbal, or emotional intimidation in any form. I will provide constructive feedback and encouragement to all players, focusing on effort, improvement, and enjoyment of the game. I will avoid favoring certain players over others and will give every player equal opportunity to play and develop their skills.
- 3. Respect for Parents and Families I will communicate openly, respectfully, and professionally with parents regarding their child's progress, attendance, and any issues that may arise. I will listen to parents' concerns and provide them with an appropriate and respectful response. I will encourage parents to be supportive and positive toward all players and coaches, creating a healthy environment for everyone involved.

I will model good sportsmanship by maintaining a calm and respectful demeanor during games, regardless of the calls made by the officials.
